

## Summer term set at MHCC June 22 with 400 sections

Summer term will begin June 22 at Mt. Hood Community College and more than 400 class sections will be available to students.

Summer students will also have a variety of sessions from which to choose. The college will offer two five-week sessions as well as the regular 10-week session. There will also be a few concentrated sessions of 10, 11

and 12 weeks.

Concentrated sessions include accounting, biology, economics or chemistry and make it possible for a student to complete a year's worth of subject hours during the summer.

In addition to the more than 400 class sections offered by the college's 13 academic divisions, MHCC is offering a variety of other

summer courses and activities to area residents.

The developmental education center will have a full schedule of skill-building credit courses in reading, writing, arithmetic and other basic skills.

The community education office has set up a group of short courses and workshops for adults as well as special summer classes designed for

children in grades one through six.

The college center will present a series of summer tours ranging from a walk of Portland's Old Town to a white water rafting trip on the Deschutes River.

Children's swimming lessons will be held at the aquatic center. Five levels of instruction in four different two-week sessions will be of-

fered.

Youth recreation for children ages 9-14 is being coordinated by the MHCC athletic department. Two sessions are scheduled for June and July.

The MHCC Maywood Park Education Center will also be offering a full range of regular classes as well as several self-paced instruction classes which allow the

student to study and progress at an individual rate.

The college's summer schedule contains a complete listing of all the academic class sections, other special programs, registration and financial aid information.

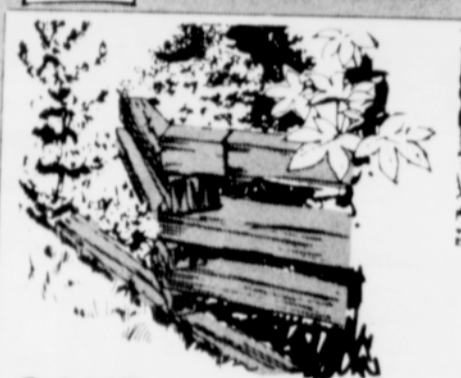

## Camp Howard opens program

A camping program for kids ages eight to 14 will be offered this summer in the forested wilderness of Camp Howard.

Located near Aims, the 240-acre camp will house a one-week program for boys from June 28 to July 4, a one-week program for girls Aug. 16-22 and six different one-week, coeducational programs in July and early August.

Nature hikes, a variety of sports activities, arts and craft projects and music programs are planned. All activities will be supervised by qualified counselors.

The camping program at Camp Howard will emphasize the spiritual, moral and social values equated with a Christian life. The camp is sponsored by the Catholic Youth Organization.

A registered nurse will be on hand at all times and a doctor will be on call. All meals will be planned and prepared by experienced cooks. Camp Howard is accredited by the American Camping Association.

The non-denominational program will cost \$75 a week for the first child and \$70 for each additional child in a family.
