Traffic rate declines with poor economy

Thirty-seven people died in Oregon traffic during May, a drop of nearly 35 percent from May last year when 57 people were killed in traffic.

The May toll brought the five-month count to 204, nearly 15 percent below the 240 fatalities recorded through May 1980, and the lowest five-month toll in at least the last six years.

Six pedestrians were among the 37 May victims. Six motorcyclists, two of whom were known to be wearing helmets, also died in May. The remaining victims were drivers or passengers in motor vehicles.

The improved highway safety picture may be due in part to the downturn in the economy, gas prices and lower travel rather than better driving, according to Motor Vehicles Division officials.
