American spirit

The recently released film "Nobody Does It Better Than You, America," which aims to capture the spirit of teamwork in this country, will be syndicated to television stations across the country during the week of June 27 through July 4.

Ed Asner will host the presentation, which focuses on three teams who exemplify the American spirit of pride and human possibility. The film is produced by Connecticut Mutual Life Insurance Co.

The first depiction is of a team of surgeons who performed a quadruple by-pass on Wimbledon champ Arthur Ashe. Other teams include the First All Children's Theater, a New York City-based repertory group, and the astronauts, crew members and technicians involved in the space shuttle project.

Group confession

Ordinary and not-so-ordinary people will share their

fears, frustrations, joys, sorrows, weaknesses and strengths with the viewing audience on "The Tom Cottle Show," to air on PBS July 4. (Local times may vary; check listings.)

Cottle, a clinical psychologist-sociologist, offers perspectives on personal issues in everyday life by talking openly to people about their experiences and the insights gained from those events.

The first program will deal with a woman who recently underwent a mastectomy and another woman, who is an amputee. Future programs will focus on the difficulties encountered by homosexuals and the problems of children of divorced parents.

NBC at Wimbledon

NBC, out to court tennis fans, will present a record total of 15 hours of live and taped coverage of the All-England Tennis Championships from Wimbledon. Telecasts begin June 27

with taped highlights of early round matches and conclude with same-day satellite coverage of the women's singles final Friday, July 3; and live coverage of the men's single final Saturday, July 4. Dick Enberg will host NBC's coverage with Bud Collins, Billie Jean King and Donald Dell doing the commentary.

Esther Rolle as Momma

The autobiography of a young black girl growing up in

the South during the Depression is the theme of a motion picture for television, "I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings," to be rebroadcast Saturday, July 4 on CBS.

The story takes place in the back hills of Vicksburg, Miss. Esther Rolle stars as Momma, a lady who turns an abandoned shack into a general store. Miss Rolle said she tried to put some of her own mother's qualities into the character she plays in the movie.
