## Obituaries

### John Rank

Funeral services for John Rank of Boring were held Tuesday in the chapel of Sandy Funeral Home. He died in Gresham June 19. He was 78.

He was born in Marshfield, Wis. on Feb. 6, 1903. His family moved to North Dakota when he was 4. After completing his education he worked as a section hand for the Northern Pacific Railroad.

Mr. Rank entered the U.S. Army in 1942 and served during World War II. After his discharge in 1944, he moved to Oregon to make his permanent home in the Boring area.

He worked at various occupations in the Gresham area. He was employed by Jantzen before retiring in 1965.

He is survived by his sisters, Margaret Jackson of Boring and Eva Weller in Utah, and many nieces and nephews.

Vault interment was at the Cliffside Cemetery in Sandy.

### Joel Ettinger

Services were held at Bateman Funeral Home in Gresham for Joel B. Ettinger of Boring who died June 15. He was 68.

Born Jan. 30, 1913 in Portland, he lived in Pennsylvania until last year, when he returned to Oregon to make his home in Boring. He was a master mechanic for Pan American Airlines until his retirement in 1965.

He is survived by three sisters, Elizabeth Flannery and Janet Henry, both of Boring, and Mahala Ettinger of Troutdale.

Burial was at Lincoln Memorial Park.

Clackamas County residents are reminded that every dog more than six months old must be licensed.

After the 60-day grace period, Jan. 1 to March 1, a late fee of \$5 is charged for voluntary purchases of the license, but if a license enforcement officer in the field cites the owner for failure to license a dog, a \$15 penalty fee is assessed.
