

Seedlings available to woodland owners

Small woodland owners in western Oregon who want forest seedlings for next winters planting can reserve those seedlings from the D.L. Phipps State Forest Nursery now.

The estimated price for this year's seedlings for Douglas fir and ponderosa pine are \$90 per thousand in lots of 1,000 or more seedlings and \$9.50 per hundred for orders of 400 to 900 seedlings.

The estimated cost for hybrid poplar is \$112 per 1,000 for orders of 1,000 or more and \$12 per 100 seedlings for orders of 100 to 900. The minimum number of reservable seedlings is 400 Douglas fir and ponderosa

pine or 100 poplar.

The State Department of Forestry has reservation blanks available at local offices and the Clackamas County extension office. Reservations will be accepted until Sept. 15 or until supplies run out.

To reserve seedlings, landowners must have fewer than 5,000 acres, manage their land for forest products, not regularly employ more than 10 persons in the production of lumber and be planning the trees for reforestation purposes.

Seedlings will become available for planting Dec. 10, 1981 and will be available until March 31, 1982.

Pacific shrimp tasty in variety of dishes

Shrimp Sunomono (Japanese-style salad)

6 ounces tiny Pacific shrimp
1/2 cup white vinegar
1 tbsp. sesame oil
1/2 cup sugar
2 tps. salt
1 tsp. monosodium glutamate
1 cucumber, thinly sliced
3 stalks celery, diagonally sliced
2 green onions, minced

Rinse shrimp with cold water; pat dry with paper towels. Set aside. Combine vinegar, sesame oil, sugar, salt and monosodium glutamate; mix well. Refrigerate dressing for at least one hour before serving to allow flavors to blend. Combine shrimp, cucumber, celery and green onion. Pour dressing over shrimp and vegetable mixture just before serving and toss.

Makes four servings. (For a light summer entree, increase shrimp to one pound).

Shrimp and Corn Salad

1/2 pound tiny Pacific shrimp
2 cups fresh corn kernels (about four ears)

1 cup chopped celery
3 green onions, chopped
curry powder to taste
mayonnaise to moisten
salt and pepper to taste

Rinse shrimp with cold water and pat dry with paper towels. Refrigerate shrimp. Cut corn away from cob with sharp knife. Transfer corn to medium saucepan; sprinkle with dash or two of salt. Add enough water to cover corn. Cover and bring to boil. Reduce heat and simmer for two or three minutes, or until just tender. Drain and rinse with cold water immediately. Cool.

Combine all remaining ingredients. Refrigerate for at least one hour before serving to allow flavors to blend.

Open-Faced Shrimp Sandwich

2 cups tiny Pacific shrimp
4 cups hard-cooked eggs, peeled
1/4 tsp. salt
1-8 tsp. pepper
1/4 tsp. dry mustard
1 tsp. minced green onion tops
1 raw egg yolk

1/4 cup heavy cream
8 slices whole wheat bread
1 cup grated sharp cheddar cheese
paprika

Rinse shrimp, dry and set aside. Separate hard-cooked egg yolks from whites; set whites aside. In small bowl, mash hard-cooked egg yolks; blend in salt, pepper, mustard and green onion. Stir in raw egg yolk and cream. Chop hard-cooked egg whites. Add egg whites and shrimp to yolk mixture.

Toast bread on one side only. Spread sandwich mixture on untoasted side of bread. Top with grated cheese and sprinkle with paprika. Bake at 375 degrees for 10 to 12 minutes or until cheese is lightly browned.

Serve open-faced. Makes four to six servings.

Curry Shrimp Boats

2 pounds tiny Pacific shrimp
3 pineapples
2 tbsps. butter
1 1/2 tps. chopped onion

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
