Marc Singer views the clothes for his roles

Marc Singer is an actor who has spent much of his life on the stage in period roles that required him to dress in knee britches or tight pantaloons.

On the screen, he has mostly escaped that image, portraying contemporary characters in such television features as "Something for Joey," "Things in Their Season," "79 Park Avenue," "Sgt. Matlovich vs. the U.S.A.F." and "The Contender."

But he is back to period clothes again for the newest role of his career, that of a brooding artist of the 1890s who finds the love of his life to be a woman from another era, in "The Two Worlds of Jennie Logan," a drama being rebroadcast on "The CBS Tuesday Night Movies," Tuesday, July 14 on CBS. Lindsay Wagner stars in the title role.

"The clothes of the late Victorian era are much less confining than those of the Elizabethan, in which I have spent so much of my career," Singer says.

His Shakespearean roles have included such classics as Bassanio in "The Merchant of Venice," Demetrius in "A Midsummer Night's Dream," Petruchio and Lucentio in different productions of "The Taming of the Shrew" and Aumerle in "Richard II." Other of his stage roles have been Christian in "Cyrano de Bergerac," Rosencrantz in "Rosencrantz and Guildenstern Are Dead," Mr. Kay in "The Contractor," Camille in "A Flea in Her Ear," Sandy in "Hay Fever," Simon in "The Caucasian Chalk Circle" and McCann in "The Birthday Party."

"My role in 'The Two Worlds of Jennie Logan' really was one of the most com-

fortable I have ever played, except for one scene where Lindsay and I tip over a canoe in a very cold lake," Singer notes. "The story is set in rural New England, and the casual attire of that area, during the '90s, was very informal, not too far removed from today's styles."

Singer did make one alteration in his usual appearance for the film: He accessorized his costume with a moustache.

"It was real," he says. "It took me two months of nurturing, and I was quite proud of it. Unfortunately, I had to shave it off immediately after finishing 'The Two Worlds of Jennie Logan' because I had to do some scenes for a movie I had made previously."

"It was harder to shave the moustache off than it was to grow it. My wife liked it, and I was rather proud of it. I rationalized by telling myself I could always replace it."

"Actually, I can wear whatever the role requires."

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
