PGE seeking 2.5 percent rate increase

Portland General Electric will raise its rates by an average of 2.5 percent to offset an increase in the wholesale rates charged by the Bonneville Power Administration.

The utility purchases power from BPA on a secondary, or as-available, basis. BPA raised its wholesale rates 59 percent on July 1.

Even though PGE does not rely solely upon BPA for power to meet its customers' needs, the federal agency's new rates will increase the utility's annualized costs by an estimated \$10.85 million in 1981.

The increased costs are for transmission of electricity to PGE through BPA lines, providing exchanged "capacity" power, purchased surplus power and existing contract sales.

The increase will raise PGE's summer residential rate from 4.143 cents to 4.257 cents per kilowatt hour. For 1,000 kwh of electricity, PGE customers will pay \$45.57, an increase of \$1.14. The \$3 monthly service charge remains unchanged.
