Set for Brightwood area

Hydro-electric plant to be studied

The Clackamas County hearings officer this Monday, July 13, will consider a conditional use permit to allow Toney's Farm Market to sell products raised in properties not owned or leased by the company.

The hearings officer will also consider three other Sandy and Hoodland-area applications at Monday's session which gets underway at 7 p.m. in the County Courthouse in Oregon City.

The produce firm is proposing to offer fruits, vegetables, dairy products, agricultural products and supplies, and horticultural products and supplies for sale at its roadside stand.

The stand on the south side of Highway 26 at its intersection with Firwood Road, is in an exclusive farm use zone.

The hearings officer will also consider a temporary permit application filed by a Sandy-area resident Leroy J. Voelker plans to establish a mobile home as a residence for his son who will act as a caretaker in his absence.

The property is at 47530

S.E. Coalman Road, two miles west of its intersection with S.E. Baty Road.

Two Hoodland area applications will also be considered.

A minor partition and variance application to reduce the required minimum lot size requirements from five acres to allow the partitioning of a lot into a 5.11-acre parcel and a 4.7-acre parcel will be considered. This property is on the northwest and northeast corners of the intersection of Truman Road and E. Aschoff Road.

The second Hoodland-area application is for a zone change. A proposal to change the zoning from recreational-residential to community commercial on the west side of Welches Road, approximately 630 feet south of its intersection with Highway 26, will be considered.

HYDRO-ELECTRIC SITE

Next Thursday, July 16, the Clackamas County hearings officer will consider a

proposal that would result in a small hydro-electric generating facility in the Brightwood area. The hearing is scheduled for 7 p.m. in the County Courthouse in Oregon City.

S.S. Investments is seek-

ing a conditional use permit to build a small hydro-electric generating facility consisting of an inlet diversion structure, transmission pipeline, a power generating building, an outlet structure and overhead transmission

line.

The facility would be built off the south end of East Country Club Drive, approximately one-half mile south of its intersection with Highway 26.

Rock race rolls tomorrow

The Sandy Cascade Soccer Club Tuesday announced plans to continue the festival tradition and host the sixth-annual event.

The focus of the event, scheduled Friday afternoon at 1 p.m. in the parking lot of Sandy DeCor, will change this year. According to Colleen Taylor, "This year is basically for the kids."

There will be five age-group races and three special races: Elimination Derby, Out-of-Towners Open and the Chamber Pot Sweepstakes.

The age-group classifications will be under 5 years old, 6-10, 11-15, 16-25 and over 25 years of age.

The Elimination Derby will pit the winners of the age-group races against one another to determine the overall champion. The Out-of-Towners Open is a race

for anybody who resides outside the Sandy-Mt. Hood area. The Chamber Pot Sweepstakes is open to all members of clubs, civic or fraternal organizations, and all retail merchants.

Ribbons and trophies will

be awarded.

Entry fees are 50 cents for those under 15 years of age; other entry fees are 75 cents.
