### Local students gain finals

A pair of local students have been selected as state finalists in two separate teenage pageants.

Audrey Renee Chapman, 16, of Sandy will compete in the state finals of the 1981 Teenworld Pageant. The competition will be held Aug. 22 at the Red Lion Motor Inn in Lloyd Center beginning at 7:30 p.m.

Bonnie Jo Erickson, 17, of Boring will compete in the state finals of the Miss United Teenager Pageant, scheduled for the Red Lion Inn July 18 at 7:30 p.m.

Chapman, a senior at Sandy High School, is the daughter of Allen and Carol Braden. She is being sponsored by Doggie Muldoon's

Her activities include membership in the school choir, solo performances, president of the Barlow Stage, painting, cooking,

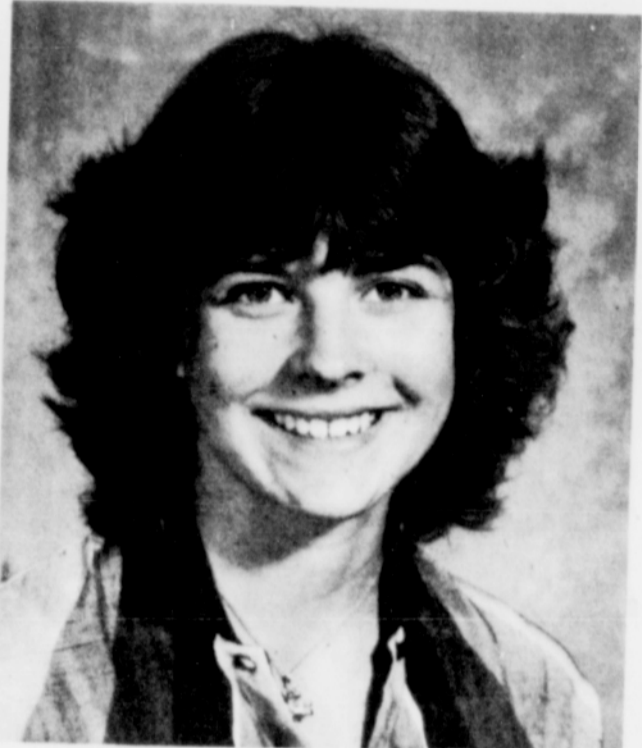
sewing, swimming, jogging, gardening and camping. She served as junior camp counselor.

## County seeks engineer

Clackamas County is looking for an engineer to serve on the Board of Appeals that interprets provisions of the state building codes and the County code for abatement of dangerous buildings.

The advisory groups include fire district representatives, a builder and an architect.

"We need an engineer who would volunteer for one or two meetings a year when questions arise about interpretations of structural re-

quirements, alternative building methods or materials or appeals," said Dick Dopp, director of Clackamas County's Development Services Division.

The Board of Commissioners will appoint someone to both appeal bodies.

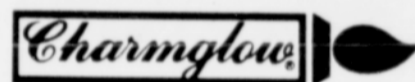

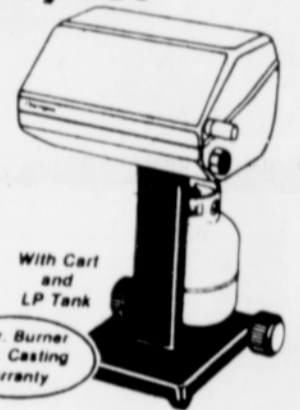

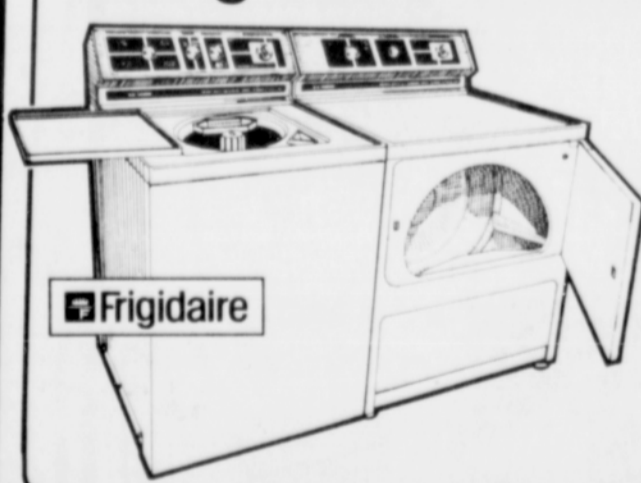
