Competition was keen in the various categories of the shoot, which included muzzleloaders, a cannon shoot and axe throwing.

The overall top shooter for the two-day competition was Jerry Keller of Troutdale. He won a rifle for being overall champ.

Second place went to Jerry Tinker of Portland, who won last year's competition. He was awarded a pistol kit. Third place honors and a hunting knife outfit went to Gresham's Terry Powers.

Keller also won Saturday's competition, while the Sunday winner was Loyd Gray of Sandy.

Tinker won the pistol and revolver competition.

The winner in Saturday's cannon shoot was John Maxwell of Sandy.

Costumes were as much a part of the event as shooting and Sarge Sanville won best military costume honors. The award for best mountain man costume went to Preacher Conley, who came all the way from Marysville, Calif. for the competition.

Dave Allen of Milwaukie won the raffle for a rifle.

A total of 113 shooters competed in the various events and there were 15 cannons in the competition.
