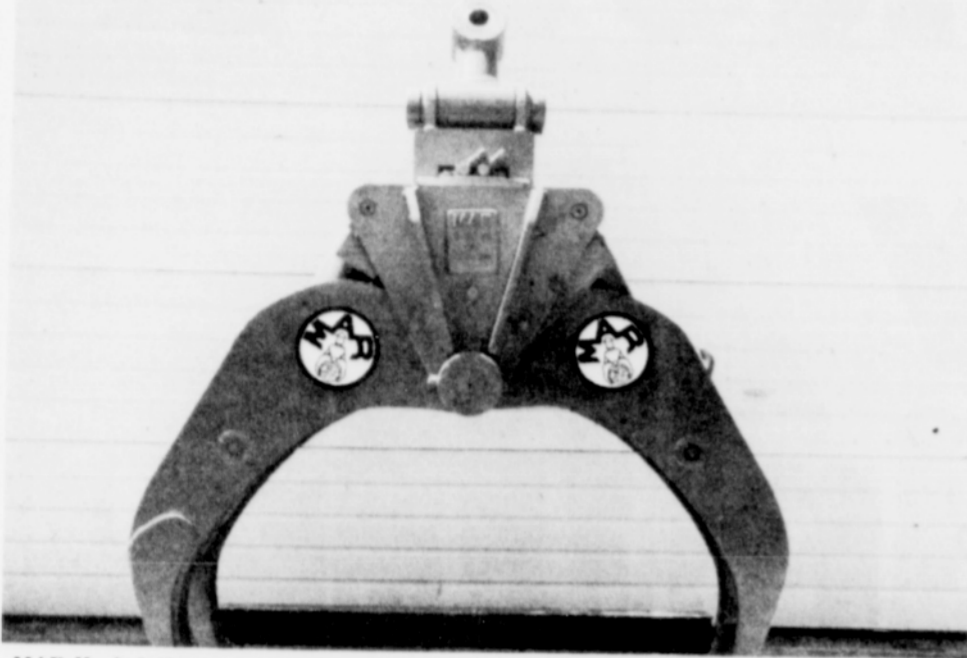

## New log grapple available

A new third-generation of MAR hydraulic log grapples has been introduced to the forest product industry by MAR Hook & Equipment, Inc. of Sandy.

The Model CR-XXX hydraulic grapples offer improvements over the first-generation MAR Model HY hydraulic grapples and the second-generation MAR CR grapples.

The continuous rotation CR-XXX offers higher rotation torque, shorter overall height and fewer parts. It also represents the "state of the art" in grapple design and construction.

There are no long spline shafts required and the rotation motor, hydraulic distributor and relief valve are all enclosed in a single unit.

Unlike many previous hydraulic grapple designs, the cylinders as well as the rotation motor are designed to be supplied with the same hydraulic pressure, 2,000-2,500 psi. Thus, it isn't necessary to have the cylinders regulated at one pressure and the rotation pressure at another pressure with the CR-XXX.

The new grapple has a

compact, rugged design and retains the MAR jaw design which has been job-tested for many operational hours in the field.

As with all MAR hydraulic log grapples, the CR-XXX has no teeth to damage logs. Patents are pending on the grapples.

MAR now offers hydraulic log grapples for loading or sorting applications in opening sizes from 36 inches to 66 inches.

Drive-up window banking is coming to Hoodland's Clackamas County Bank at Welches.

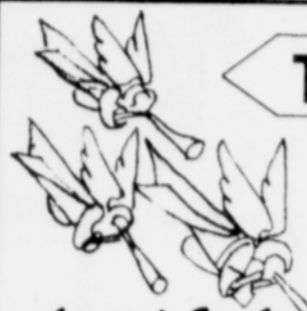
The branch office, built in 1967, will be completely redone in a mountain motif, compatible with the area

## Chamber move was friendly

A Sandy Chamber of Commerce decision to eat elsewhere was reached amicably and without mention of the word "ultimatum," as previously reported, according to Chamber and T.J.'s restaurant spokesmen.

The chamber agreed by unanimous voice vote last week to move its Tuesday noon luncheon meetings from T.J.'s Fireside Dining to Tollgate Inn after disagreement over limited menu selection.

The menu recently was restricted to one hot-plate item, after full menu card selections and even limited choices presented delays in service with late-comers and tied up restaurant grill space, according to restaurant owner Bill Herzog.

Herzog said he was asked by Chamber president Dick Busby at the start of the year to limit the menu to one item each week to speed service. In recent weeks some

Chamber members have voiced dissatisfaction with the limited selection and asked acting chairman Jones to talk things over with restaurant owners.

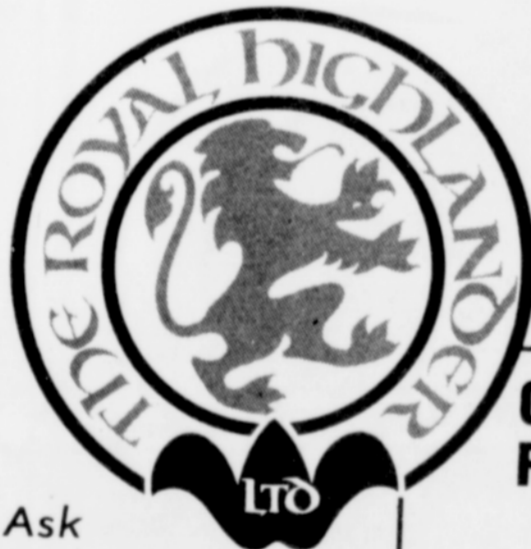

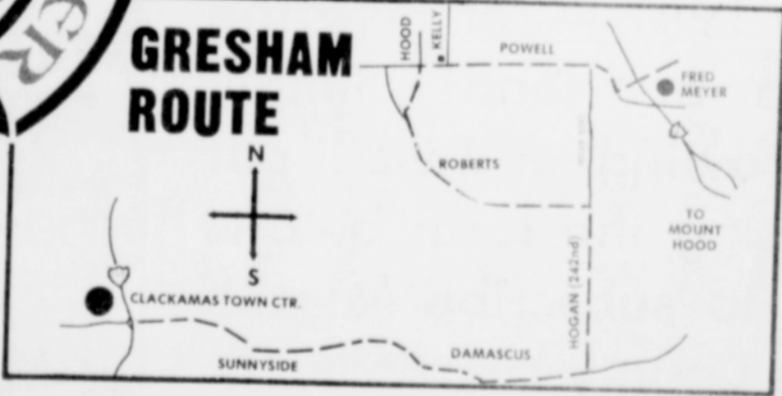
