Jones named top retailer

Chuck Jones of Boring has been nominated by the Sandy Area Chamber of Commerce as local retailer of the year. The annual contest is sponsored by Associated Oregon Industries who will name a state winner within a month. The Sandy shop owner was nominated formally by Sandy Area Merchants, a chamber committee he once chaired before becoming chamber vice president this year. His original nomination, however, came in the form of a letter to the editor

in the May 28 Sandy Post. "Dear Diogenes," wrote Charles R. Anderson of Boring. "Sound the trumpets, ring the bells and blow out your lantern, old man. I have found him at last—an honest man. He runs a small business in Sandy called Ferguson's Power Equipment. Like the man said, he stands behind what he sells. If there is a 'business man of the year award' in Sandy, I would like to nominate him." Jones left a 15-year career in insurance throughout Iowa, Wisconsin, California

and Oregon to enter the saw shop business in partnership with Jack Ferguson here in 1975. He bought out his partner in 1977. The shop now carries a full line of lawn and garden power equipment and chainsaws. In addition to chamber of commerce and SAM offices, Jones has served the city of Sandy on a sign review committee and been a member of the local Lions Club.

Lottery picks woodcutters

Sandy area residents interested in cutting some wood for the winter have a unique opportunity, if their name is selected in a special lottery.

An "escorted" wood cutting opportunity will be available for a few hundred individuals selected through a lottery held by the Zigzag Ranger District, Mt. Hood National Forest.

According to Carla Jones, head of the district's

firewood cutting program, this approach is being used to remove available firewood from the North Mountain area. The area is located just north of Brightwood, but the only access is through the Bull Run Watershed. The city of Portland requires that the Forest Service escort all woodcutters through the Bull Run.

Approximately 100 persons will be allowed to enter

the area Sept. 12, 13, 19, 20 and 26.
