

Oktoberfest features baked goods

The annual Community Presbyterian Church Oktoberfest, featuring homemade pie and baked goods, will be held from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. this Saturday, Oct. 3, in the church basement. The church is located at the corner of Scenic Street and Meinig Avenue.

Police say

Fall brings citation increase

With the arrival of fall, school is in session and, Sandy police report, citations for driving offenses and minors in possession of intoxicants are increasing.

Last Friday evening, police cited a 16-year-old male and a 17-year-old female in separate incidents for being in possession of intoxicants. Sunday, another 17-year-old female was cited for the same offense by Sandy police.

Early last Friday morn-

ing, Celeste Joan Gainer, 19, of Sandy was cited by Sandy police for driving while under the influence of intoxicants near the intersection of Pioneer Boulevard and Strauss Street. Robert Ward Jones Jr., 40, of Sandy was also stopped Friday for driving while under the influence of intoxicants near the intersection of Highway 26 and Bluff Road.

Also on Friday, Donald Brant reported the theft of a bicycle, valued at \$169, from

Sandy Union High School. Police said this is the third bicycle in recent days that has been reported missing. If anyone knows any information or has seen any incident relating to bicycle thefts, they are asked to contact the Sandy Police Department.

A 14- and 15-year-old were cited for shoplifting last Friday and released to their parents. The two were accused of taking four packages of BBs, valued at \$1.96, from Williams Thriftway.

A Bluff Road resident reported last Friday that someone had taken to bowling balls decorating his front lawn. Someone had apparently taken the balls and rolled them down Bluff Road, where they were recovered by Sandy police.

John Sandy of Sandy reported to police last Friday evening that someone had scratched his Chevrolet Corvette with broken bottles while it was parked at Sandy Union High School. Damage to the vehicle was estimated at \$1,500.

County officials raise septic tank charges

Sandy residents who plan to build a new home that won't be connected with local sewer service will notice an increase in their pre-construction bills soon.

Fees charged by Clackamas County for septic tank permits, licenses and studies are going up.

County Commissioner Stan Skoko said the commission approved increases for such fees at a meeting last Thursday.

The increases allow the Environmental Services Department to continue operating the septic evaluation division on a cost-covering basis. "The fees will just cover their increased costs," Skoko said. He said a slump in the construction industry has left less business for the department. "The work done in that office requires certain people to be on the staff, and there is not sufficient business to keep up the income," Skoko said. "But it is not like we have a bunch of

idle people around." Dick Polson, head of the county soils department, said the increase for feasibility studies is from \$75 to \$135. "We are raising some of the fees up to the maximum the state will allow," he said. There are fees for studies, permits and licenses for installers, he said.
