

Police report burglaries, thefts during past week

Sandy residents reported a pair of thefts and a pair of burglaries this past week. Last Friday, Oct. 2, a burglary was reported at a Bluff Road residence. Cash was taken from the home after someone entered the house through a window while the family was away for a football game. Chester Rule of Mount Vernon told Sandy police Sunday that someone had taken a suitcase, a wallet and some cash from his vehicle between 10:30 p.m. and 1:30 a.m. while it was parked outside Toni's Lounge. The vehicle was not locked. A Gary Street resident told police that money was taken from his locked vehicle while it was parked outside his house. Finally, a Hood Street resident reported Monday that someone had entered his garage through a window and taken a chainsaw sometime between 7 a.m. Sunday and 7 a.m. Monday.

Sunday, police arrested Wayne Paul Carroll, 20, of Sandy on two warrants issued by Clackamas County officials. He was lodged in the county jail on charges of possession of a slugging weapon and possession of liquor by a minor. Another Sandy man, Jimmy Keith Brandon, 25, was arrested Tuesday on warrants issued by the county. He was lodged in the county jail on two theft charges. Bail was set at \$7,000.

Blaze destroys Sandy hunter's home

A Sandy home was destroyed last Thursday night when a fire burned undetected for nearly six hours before firefighters were called to battle the flames.

An electrical problem in the circuit to the refrigerator started the fire in the home of Frank Evanoski, 16909 SE 362nd Drive. By the time the fire was reported, flames were shooting through the roof. Evanoski had left earlier in the day to go hunting in Eastern Oregon.

Thirty-one firefighters from Sandy and a support crew from the Boring Fire District battled the fire for nearly an hour before it was under control. Controlling the flames was difficult, according to Gallagher, because of the composition in the roof. He said a layer of shingles was topped with composition. In turn, cedar shakes were on top of that.

As a result, the composition was burning between the layers of shingles and shakes. Firefighters had to tear out what was left of the roof to get the fire out, he said. Gallagher estimated that the fire had been smoldering since 5:30 p.m. Once it got started, it raced up a stairwell to the second story. Damage to the building and contents was estimated at \$82,000. During the week, Sandy firefighters responded to 14 alarms. Along with the house fire, district personnel answered alarms for eight first-aids, three automobile accidents, and two mutual aids.
