## Obituaries

### August Bartsch

Longtime area resident August Bartsch died Sept. 2. He was born May 15, 1887, on the family farm on Revenue Road.

Mr. Bartsch worked on the family farm and sawmills at an early age. He married Lyda Bramhall in 1914. They lived in the Orient area until moving to Bend where he worked in a mill.

They returned to Sandy in the 1930s and he worked with his brothers in a Cherryville sawmill and then they moved the mill to Wemme. They sold the mill in 1937 and began farming and selling berries.

When Mr. Bartsch quit farming, he drove the U.S. mail route to Government Camp. His first wife, Lyda, died in 1957.

He married Iris in 1964. They sold their Sandy home in 1971 and moved to Gresham where he lived until his death.

He is survived by his wife, Iris; a nephew Harold Bartsch of Pendleton; nieces, Lois Bennett, Bertha Gunderson and Grace Rieder of Boring, and many grand- and great-grand nieces and nephews.

### Margaret Kotzman

Services for former Sandy postal employee Margaret H. Kotzman will be held today (Thursday) in the chapel of Sandy Funeral Home at 2 p.m. Private interment will be at Firhill Memorial Cemetery in Sandy.

Mrs. Kotzman died at her Hermiston home on Oct. 4 after a lengthy illness. She was 85.

She was born near Toledo, Wash. on June 22, 1896. She began working at the Sandy post office in 1935.

She married Adolph Kotzman in 1939. They made their home in the Sandy-Boring area. She continued working at the post office until her 1966 retirement.

She was a member of the Boring Rebekah Lodge, Sandy Order of Eastern Star and the National Association of Retired Employees.

They moved to Hermiston six years ago. Mr. Kotzman died in 1978.

Mrs. Kotzman is survived by her brother, Glenn Benedict of Newberg; a sister, Hazel Rothery of Ryderwood, Wash.; stepsons, Carl and Glenn Loundree, and several nieces and nephews.
