Gymnasts at best in Canby win

The Pioneer gymnastics team improved its scores in three out of four events last week, giving them the highest team score they've had all year.

The 120.7 points got them safely past Canby, and put their record at 2-2.

"I felt that this was probably one of the best meets we've had all season because we had everyone there and healthy," Coach Molly Knudson said earlier this

week.

That includes four all-arounds, which is fairly unusual. "It's my feeling that an all-around is going to be a little bit stronger because they're working all four events rather than specializing in one or two," Knudson said.

All-arounds for the Pioneers are Janice Hawkins, Kim Parmenter, Lori Bouck and Kathy George.

Hawkins also was praised. She finished in the top four in each event.

Bouck, a senior, as is Hawkins, has improved her score with each outing. "She's just starting to come on right now," Knudson said.

SAM ROMEY broke the school's course record, which was set by Fred Sprol of Astoria in 1978.

Romey, a sophomore, took the record by only a fraction of a second, running the 5,000-meter course in 15:47.

Coach Scott McMullen was not only pleased to have the

record in the possession of a Sandy runner, but was happy with the team outing as well. Both the boys and the girls won their respective divisions in the triangular last week.

While Romey finished first for the boys, Gayle Roth got a first-place finish for the girls, running the 3,000 meters in 11:58.

The team traveled to Salem for a meet Saturday, and though they didn't have all their top runners there, due to illnesses, sophomore Sharon Jensen did provide one bright spot, knocking 47 seconds off her previous best time for an 11:13 3,000 meters.
