

Hearty beef delight, crazy crust apple pie recipes offered

Beef Delight

For each pound of browned and drained hamburger add:
2 cups celery
2 tablespoons onions
Saute the celery and onions and add to the hamburger.

Then add:
1/2 cup water chesnuts
Dash of soy sauce
1 can of cream of chicken
1 can cream of mushroom soup
1 can chow mein noodles for topping
Pepper, if desired

Add very little, if any, salt to the hamburger as the condensed soups are high in salt content. Taste for seasoning before putting into a greased baking dish. Top with chow mein noodles and bake in moderate oven, 350 degrees, for 20 minutes. From the files of Lynnette Biggers, Portland.

Mandarin Chicken Salad

1/2 cup mayonnaise
1/2 cup marshmallow creme
1/2 teaspoon grated orange rind
1/2 cup chopped candied ginger
3 cups chopped cooked chicken
Cantaloupe rings
1 cup chopped celery
1 cup seedless grapes
1 can mandarin orange segments

1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Combine mayonnaise, marshmallow creme, orange rind and ginger. Mix. Pour in chicken, celery, grapes, oranges and seasonings. Toss.

Serve in melon rings. Serves 6. From the files of Mildred Sargent, Portland. It is getting near the end of the season for delicious cantaloupes. Let's make this luncheon salad before it's too late.

Now is the time to make nourishing desserts from apples which are plentiful and relatively inexpensive. The following recipe makes the best apple crisp I have ever made. I have been asked to repeat it. The last time I published it was in 1974.

Apple Crisp

Combine and place in a greased 8 x 8 or 9 x 9 inch baking dish:

4 cups sliced apples

1 tablespoon flour

1/2 cup white sugar

Combine and sprinkle over top of apples:

1/4 cup brown sugar

1/3 cup butter or margarine

1/4 teaspoon nutmeg

1/2 cup oatmeal

1/4 teaspoon soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

Bake for 30 minutes at 350 degrees. Serve warm with ice cream, whipped topping or cream. Serves 6-8. From the files of Helen Sulzbach, Sandy.

Apple Cake

3 tablespoons shortening

1 cup sugar

1 egg

1 teaspoon vanilla

3 cups pared, diced apples

1 cup flour

1 teaspoon soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon nutmeg

1/2 cup walnuts

Cream shortening and gradually add sugar. Add egg and vanilla, mix well. Add apples, sifted flour, spices and salt. Stir in nuts. Use ungreased 8 or 9 inch square pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 40-50 minutes. Serve with whipped cream, ice cream or a sauce. Serves 6-8. From the files of the late Mrs. Arleigh Hall, Sandy, Oregon. Crazy Crust Apple Pie

1 cup all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking powder

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 tablespoon sugar

1 egg

23 cup shortening

3/4 cup water

1 (1 pound 5 ounce) can apple pie filling

1 tablespoon lemon juice

1 tablespoon lemon juice

1/2 teaspoon apple pie spice or cinnamon

In a small bowl, combine flour, baking powder, salt, sugar, egg, shortening and water. Blend well; beat 2 minutes at medium speed of mixer. Pour batter into 9 x 1 1/4 inch pie pan. Combine pie filling, lemon juice and spice; pour into center of batter. Do not stir. Bake at 425 degrees for 45 to 50 minutes. (For fresh pie filling: 2 1/4 cups peeled sliced apples and 1 tablespoon lemon juice with 1/3 cup sugar, 2 tablespoons flour and 1/2 teaspoon pie spice or cinnamon. Pour into center of batter. Do not stir. Sprinkle with 1 to 2 teaspoons brown sugar. Bake 400 degrees 35 to 40 minutes.) Serves 6. From the files of Katherine Dabbs, Camp Hill, Ala.

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
