

Evangelical Free Church dedication Sunday

The new Mt. Hood Evangelical Free Church complex, built of logs with the work done primarily by church members, will be dedicated Sunday at 3 p.m.

The public is invited to attend the service.

Ground was broken for the project in 1980, with work getting underway full force by late summer.

The majority of the work was done by members and friends of the church, which included assisting a sawyer in forming and peeling the logs, and laying the founda-

tion. They assisted a professional log building construction crew from Idaho in erecting the building. Other work done by members includes plumbing, electrical work, heating, sheetrocking, painting, paneling, wallpapering, and the laying of countertops, linoleum, carpeting and stonework for the sanctuary.

The church was founded by Steve Bielenberg, John Cook, Jim Olson and Stan Wall. Wall is the pastor. The first meeting was on Jan. 4, 1976.

The congregation met in homes on the mountain, at Camp Arrah Wanna, and then settled in a home on Lolo Pass Road in the summer of 1976.

The congregation rapidly expanded and outgrew the Lolo Pass site. They purchased property on the north side of Highway 26, across from the Hoodland Shopping Center, in November of 1978.

Members felled trees in 1979 to clear the site and allow the logs time to season.

The first service held in the Fellowship Hall of the

new building was April 5, 1981.

Work has continued throughout the summer to ready the building for final occupancy.

Founders Olson, Cook and

Bielenberg will speak at the dedication, and a slide show will be presented showing the growth of the church. The dedication address will be by Dr. Irving M. Hedstrom, district

superintendent, Pacific Northwest District, Evangelical Free Church. Vocal numbers will be performed by Cheryl Adams and Ed Steubs.

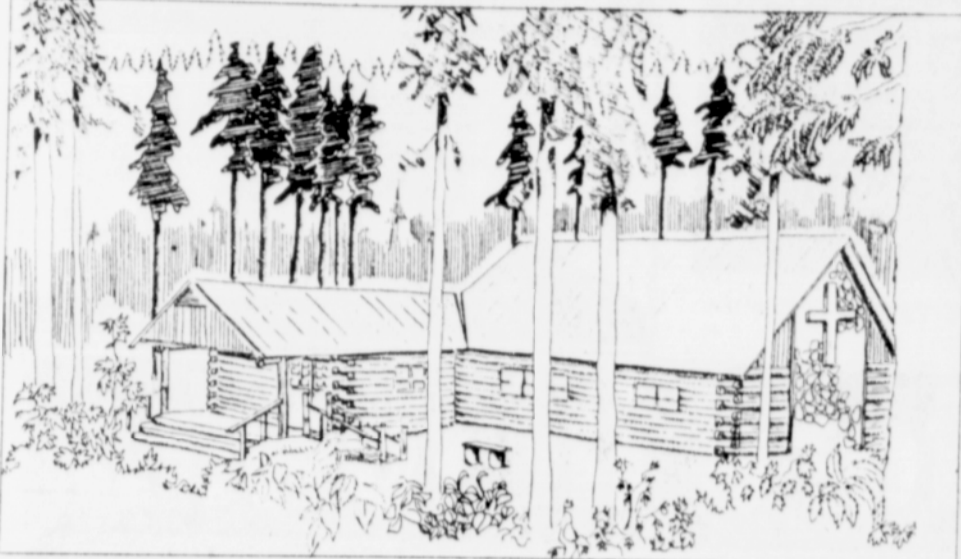
A reception will follow the dedication.

Current membership is approximately 65. Sunday attendance averages 115 at the worship service, with 20 to 25 attending junior church.

Sunday school is held at 9:45 a.m. Worship services

are at 11 a.m. A Wednesday night bible study session is held at the church at 7 p.m.

The church also sponsors a singles club, a couples club, junior and senior teen clubs, and a Cub Scout troop.

County, ECOS to discuss official planning status

The Environmental Committee on Suitability (ECOS) will go before the Clackamas County commissioners today to seek official recognition as the Community Planning Organization (CPO) for the Hoodland area.

Carolyn Smith, ECOS vice chairperson, and Marilyn Leslie, the organization's secretary-treasurer, will be

making the presentation before the commissioners.

The boundaries of the CPO would extend from the outskirts of Rhododendron on the east to Wildcat Creek on the west, and would be bordered by National Forest land on the north and south.

Smith said the purpose of the group is to gather information on proposed development and plans for the Mt.

Hood Corridor, and disperse them to interested persons or organizations. She said that in the past the information has been difficult to obtain, thus making it difficult for residents to endorse or oppose a particular project.

She said that the group was not set up as an anti-development organization, but to encourage "suitable" development.

Leary joins safety board

Two Clackamas County residents were appointed to the Clackamas County Traffic Safety Commission by the county commissioners at their October meeting.

Kent F. Leary of Boring was appointed to serve a term to expire in August, 1983.

Leary is a sergeant with the Gresham Police Department.

Also appointed was David C. Sprecker of Oregon City, a safety and engineering representative for Transport Indemnity Company.

He will fill the unexpired term of former Gladstone

Police Chief Dave Clemens, who has resigned from the commission.

The Traffic Safety Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the county commissioners on traffic safety matters. They concentrate, primarily, on the promotion of safety through training and education of the police.

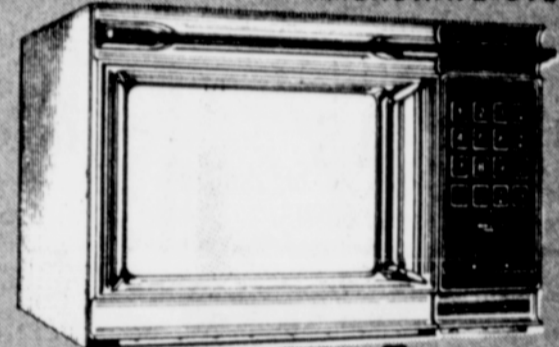

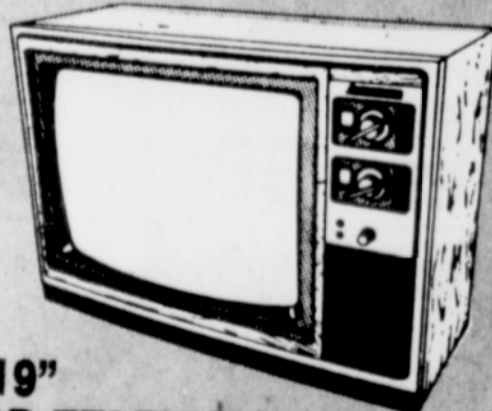
