

Increase of carbon dioxide causes concern

Although carbon dioxide (CO₂) makes up only about three hundredths of one percent of the earth's atmosphere, almost every person and place on the globe could be affected by a doubling of CO₂ in the atmosphere, Oregon State

University studies show. The West Coast of the United States, for instance, might well have a decrease in rainfall and soil moisture, coupled with warmer temperatures that

could cause shifts in growing areas and agricultural crops, explains Michael Schlesinger, OSU professor of atmospheric sciences. It could significantly change the way of life from the pre-

sent. Schlesinger has been charting the worldwide climatic changes that could come. The work at OSU with computer climate simulation models has

drawn world attention because it is one of the most comprehensive projects of its kind. The OSU modeling work is funded by the National Science Foundation and the U.S. Depart-

ment of Energy. Other scientists involved with Schlesinger include Larry Gates, Young-June Han, Jeong-Woo Kim and David Pollard.

"With the OSU atmospheric general circulation model for the world, a glimpse can be gained of what climatic changes may come to every part of the globe from the continued build-up of CO₂ in the at-

mosphere," the OSU atmospheric scientist observed. The OSU studies are based on a projected doubling (Continued on Page 9)
