

## POW held no animosity

One well-known area veteran, the late Charles Hickey, had no animosities toward the Japanese, though he was a prisoner of war for three years and one day.

"He always had kind words for everyone. He was just that type of person," said Maxine Hickey recently.

Hickey died Oct. 6 at the age of 61. The Hickeys had been married for 29 years. They met "though some people at The Store," and stayed in Brightwood after marrying.

Hickey was captured in Corregidor, Philippines. Mrs. Hickey said her husband didn't talk about those times much at all.

She did say that her husband visited with a man he'd known from his service days just a

month or two before he died.

Hickey had driven a school bus for Welches School, but had most recently worked as a security guard. He had retired about two years ago "due to health reasons."

Asked if his health may have been somewhat related to the conditions he suffered through as a POW, Mrs. Hickey said, "I don't know. I rather imagine the heart problem was developed from that. I don't know for sure."

Her husband liked to fish. Deer hunting has been Maxine's avocation.

"Yeah, I like to go hunting," she said. "He'd go with me, but he wasn't too hot on the idea."

Although she hasn't been for several years,

she said there's a chance she might go next year.

"My brother lives in Bend. I could go over there and stay with him, and go from there, because we hunt in that

general area."

Mrs. Hickey also suffered the loss of her mother on Oct. 30.

She said a person just has to carry on. "You have to when you have family close," she said.

## Skiers' skills are in demand

Nordic skiers who love the quiet of the winter woods, and the feel of untracked snow; alpine skiers who love the ease and speed of a carved turn—come share your skills and joy with us.

Shared Outdoor Adventure Recreation (SOAR) is an outdoor program for physically disabled adults

in the Portland area. From January through April, SOAR offers nordic and alpine ski instruction for people with a variety of disabilities. SOAR needs volunteers, intermediate to advanced skiers who want to share their love of the outdoors and the sport of skiing with a new skier.

As a volunteer you will learn the skills you need to assist a disabled skier, skills such as sighted-guide techniques, transfers, how to use a wheelchair and some basic sign language. Training sessions for volunteers are scheduled for Dec. 3, 8, and 10 from 7 to 9:30 p.m. at the Easter Seal Activity Center, 5757 S.W. Macadam Ave.

After training, you will be paired with a disabled companion. You will assist your companion in a series of four ski lessons with an experienced instructor. Cross-country lessons are on weekends. Alpine lessons are swing-shift weekdays, in the late afternoon and early evening. In 1981, 94 outdoor enthusiasts volunteered with SOAR, sharing their abilities with

126 disabled people. Many of these volunteers will return in 1982, but many more are needed.

Honored from this area was RiAnne Williams, daughter of Larry Williams of S.E. Bointano Road, Sandy. She is a nursing major.

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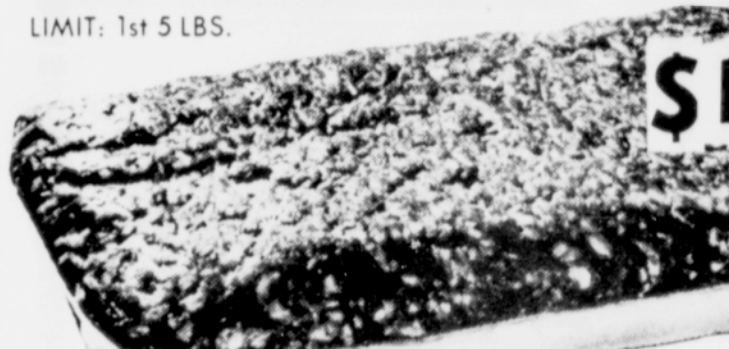
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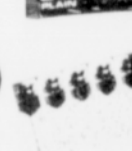
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
