Soccer all-stars will be back

The two Sandy soccer players that made the Timber Valley all-star team will be back next year.

Junior Kevin Fabryski, a center-fullback, and sophomore Tim Pullen, a center-forward, were both optimistic about the prospects for next year's team, pointing out that they had a young team, and adding that there are some good players on the junior varsity.

The Pioneers had a 3-8 season, and several one-point games.

"We're learning," Coach Ron Welsh said. "We're improving every year and we've got a lot of talent. We've got more talent now than we've ever had before."

About Fabryski, Welsh said, "He's a highly skilled player as far as soccer talent. He's a very intelligent player, and he's also in very good condition. Beyond that, he has kind of that magical ability

to create something." Welsh said that that is important in soccer, a game where there are not set plays.

Fabryski, a defensive player, received the

Pioneers' Most Valuable Player award this year.

Pullen is an offensive player, and Sandy's leading scorer.

"Tim has that ability to hit a little flick shot, and

has that kind of good feint that draws the man off just long enough to slip the ball in.

"It's just a matter of opportunity. He's in the right place at the right time."
