Timeshare stops unlicensed sales

Mt. Hood Timeshare has voluntarily stopped selling its 30-year vacation plan by unlicensed persons at the Green Tee Motel in Welches, according to the Oregon State Real Estate Division.

Dick Wilson, supervisor of the subdivision section, said Monday that his office ordered all companies involved in the venture to provide documents related to the operations and sales of timeshare.

He said the majority of the information is related to consumer protection and was to have been submitted to his office by last Wednesday, Nov. 11.

Wilson said the information is still coming in.

He hopes the problems between the vacation plan and the state can be straightened out as quickly as possible and he is getting cooperation from the primary shareholder in the

project, Carl Bright of Welches.

"The information continues to flow in from the Mt. Hood Timeshare and Carl Bright," Wilson said. "The file is still being reviewed and will be updated as the information flows in."

Both Bright and American Guaranty have indicated that they will request a hearing if the project cannot get approved by the state.

He said that when the rest of the information is received it will go into the real estate commissioner's public report that "spells out an accurate disclosure of what the public is buying."

Wilson said this report would serve as a "good flag to the consumer," outlining the responsibilities of both the buyers and the sellers.

Wilson's office is still awaiting information concerning the management agreement between the

Green Tee Timeshare operation and the Red Lion Resort Company which manages Bowman's Golf Course and the Rippling River Resort.

In addition, Wilson said, the licensing section of the Real Estate Division required that all persons involved in timeshare sales were to be licensed within the state by last Sunday, Nov. 15.

This includes closers—persons who draw

up the contract with buyers—and tour guides. Wilson said that these licensed sales persons would be accountable directly to the broker, Bright, who is licensed in Oregon.

"Anyone promoting and selling timeshare will have to have a license," said Wilson. "A tour guide is just as liable as a person who closes, and should have the proper training in real estate."
