# Sandy teen in critical condition

Alcohol was not a factor in the Nov. 6 accident that left one Sandy Union High School student dead and another critically injured, according to Lt. Lonnie Ryan, Clackamas County Sheriff's department information officer.

The report from the Oregon State Police lab shows the youths did not have dangerous levels of alcohol in their blood.

Deputies had found alcohol in the vehicle.

William "Chris" Jones remains in critical condition in Gresham Community Hospital. He suffered head and internal injuries.

Jones, a Redland resident, was riding with two other 17-year-olds from Sandy Union High School, when the vehicle swerved into the path of a Tri-Met bus.

Dean E. Fischer of Redland was driving the four-wheel drive vehicle. He sustained several broken bones, but he now is resting at home.

Carey L. Larson of Boring died as a result of injuries suffered in the accident.
