Adventists start drive

Church members contribute 90 percent of the funds for these programs. It's the last 10 percent given by friends of the church at this time that provides the boost, Clark added.

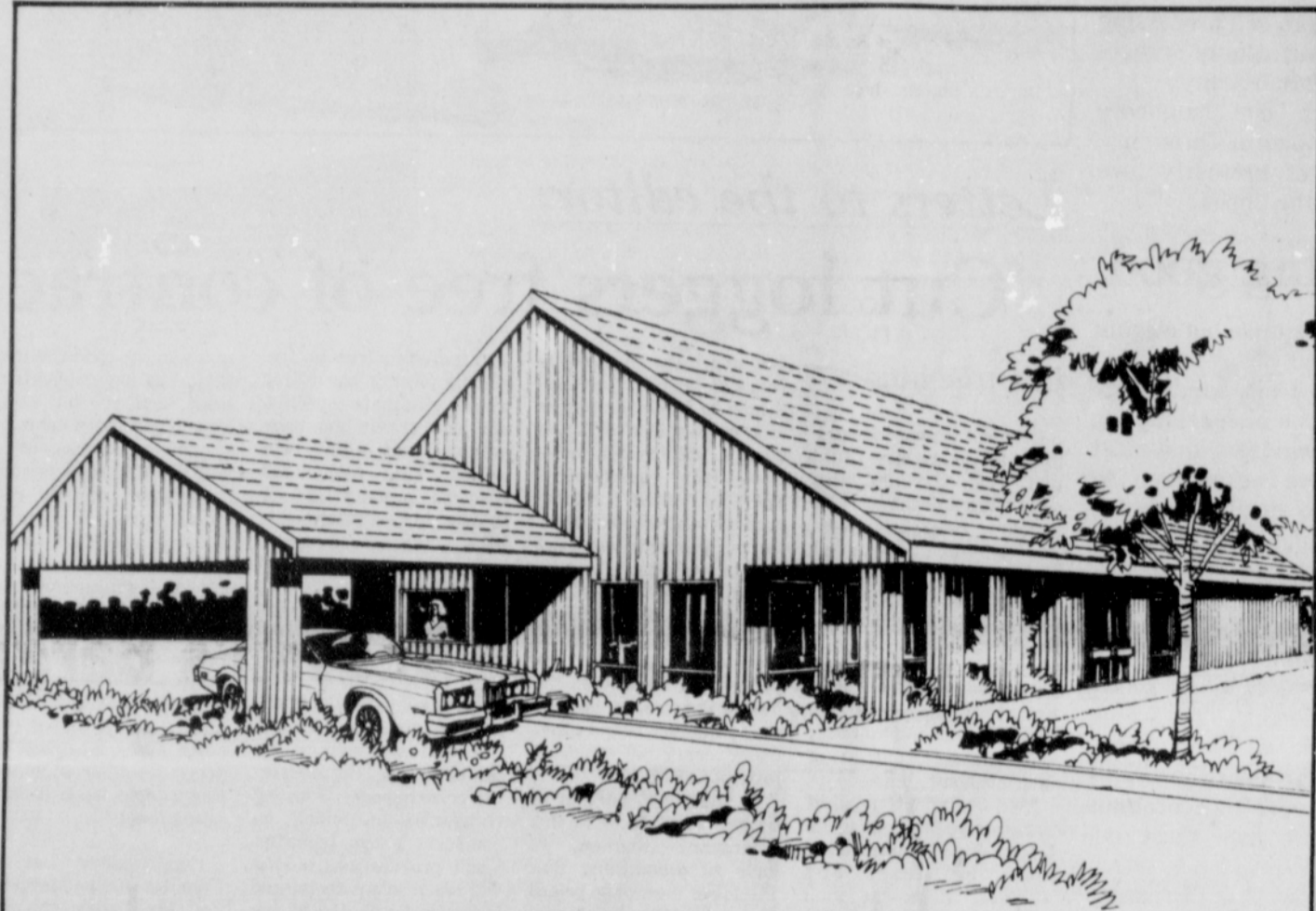
