## Recipes fight cancer

Recipes from 300 Oregonians have been collected in a new cookbook, published by the Oregon Division of the American Cancer Society, now available locally.

Featuring Oregon products from apples to zucchini, cookbook sales are expected to raise more than \$100,000 for the fight against cancer.

Locally, the book is available at Williams Thriftway, the Sandy Rexall Drug and the Oregon Candy Farm, east of Sandy on Highway 26.

All 300 recipes came from volunteers of the Oregon Division, except for some famous recipes from some of the state's best restaurants.

Mo's clam chowder from Newport, The Ringside's onion rings from Portland,

and Hungarian coffee cake from the Village Green in Cottage Grove are among the samplings found in the restaurant section.

Other goodies range from Scripture Cake to Microwave Rice Pudding. All recipes submitted were screened for completeness prior to publication.

Spiral bound with four-color cover photographs of Oregon scenes, the book is available for a minimum \$6 contribution to the local units of the Cancer Society. The money raised with aid the continuation of cancer programs in research, education, prevention and service.
