Stars perform to support charity

When it comes to aiding good causes, the mere lending of a celebrity name to a newspaper advertisement often can do some good.

But many performers give of their personal efforts, as well. For sheer enthusiasm and hard sell, current honors go to croaky-voiced, humorous, attractive Susan Saint James, long the co-star of Rock Hudson on "McMillan and Wife" and this season, on NBC, the star of "The Kid from Nowhere" (Jan. 4), in which she plays the mother of a retarded child who finds a sense of achievement through the project called the Special Olympics.

In truth, as well as fiction, the Special Olympics — competitions tailored to train and give a sense of achievement to retarded and handicapped youngsters — is a cause she champions.

She explained at a press conference last month that she was pressured by one of her bosses a few years ago to make a personal appearance at a local (athletic) meet. That one encounter with the Olympics project, conceived and fostered by siblings and in-laws of the late President John Kennedy, became her continuing stand-up-and-cheer personal commitment.

Susan continued, "I have custody of my two children only on weekends — and no way I want that taken away, so I take my kids with me to the meets around the country. And we fly coach because this is at my personal expense."

Other performers in "The Kid from Nowhere" are also avid supporters of the Special Olympics, Susan added. Loretta Swit of "M*A*S*H" is one, as is the script's writer, Judy Farrell, the wife of Mike Farrell, who plays Alan Alda's sidekick, B.J. Hunnicutt, on "M*A*S*H."

Farrell, who once said that as a child he had been abused, also endorses causes to aid

battered children.

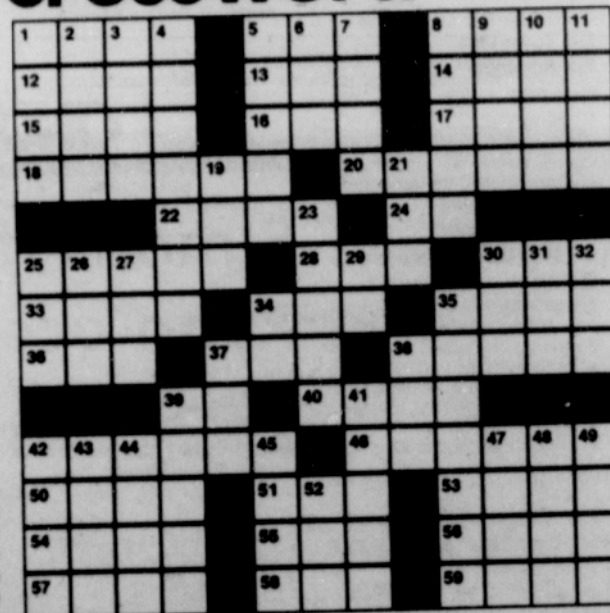
UNICEF, to aid children the world over who lack both sufficient food and medical attention, has long had a powerful champion in comedian Danny Kaye, who pilots his own plane to remote places to entertain the children and raise funds.

A year ago the National Council on Alcoholism's Celebrity Golf Tournament in Las Vegas had a willing volunteer host in Gordon MacRae.

But health causes are not the only attractions for celebrity support. The Episcopal Actors Guild, which has its headquarters at the historic Little Church Around the Corner in New York City, has voted in two major show folks as vice presidents — Joan Fontaine and Rex Harrison. Both are taking an active role in vitalizing the guild itself and aiding the picturesque church which opened its arms to actors over a hundred years ago when other churches shunned them.

Last month a statue of Jesus in the courtyard was vandalized and toppled to the ground, a further burden to a structure already in need of repair. To aid the cause, Rex Harrison is personally leading a tour of the church (Jan. 6). A party will follow.
