Baha'is commemorate slain Iranians

The Sandy Baha'i community conducted a memorial observance Sunday in memory of eight national leaders of the persecuted Baha'i Faith in Iran who were secretly executed in December by government authorities.

According to reports received by the Baha'is of Sandy, these members of the Baha'i National Assembly were abducted several weeks ago along

with two other Baha'is as they met in a private home in Teheran.

It was reported that the assembly members had been held without charge in a Teheran prison. No trials were announced and no official statements about the executions were made. None of the victims' families were notified and five of the bodies were buried in the infidels section of a Muslim graveyard

in Teheran.

This marked the second time that National Assembly members have been seized in a year and a half. The first group of nine disappeared along with two other Baha'i officials Aug. 20, 1980. They have not been seen or heard from since.

"The tragic news just received suggests the first group of National Assembly members may have suffered the same fate," said Bill Knight-Weiler, chairman of the Sandy Baha'i Assembly.

"It removes any doubt as to the determination of the fanatics in Iran to eliminate the leadership and thus destroy the Baha'i community in that country," he said.

"There appears to be no official intention of revealing the executions of the Baha'i leadership. The in-

formation about the nighttime executions was leaked through a reliable source," Knight-Weiler said.

Since its inception in Iran 137 years ago, the Baha'i Faith has aroused the opposition of Iran's fundamentalist Muslim clergy who regard the newer religion as a heresy.

Baha'is believe that the founder of their religion, Baha'u'llah, is the most recent prophet of God. His teachings about the common foundation of the world's religions, the oneness of all races, the equality of men and women and the need for establishing a universal government for the maintenance of lasting peace have stirred the violent opposition of the fundamentalist elements in Iran, according to Knight-Weiler.
