CCC to host clinic for writers

Clackamas Community College is the recipient of a \$1,454 grant for a "regional writers" series by the Oregon Committee for the Humanities.

"Writers' Visions of the Western Landscape" will feature five Western authors discussing their relationship with the region and how it affects their work.

Craig Lesley, CCC English professor and director of the series, said, "This series will approach the ways in which the literature of this region defines the Western sense of identity. It's particularly timely because Western writing is developing now."

He cited Frost's New England, Faulkner's South, and Lewis' Midwest as regions with clearly

defined identities. The West traditionally has been thought "provincial" by the big publishing houses, he said.

Glen Love, professor at the University of Oregon, will speak Feb. 17 on "Oregon Literature: Coming to Terms with the Land."

March 9, author John Keeble will discuss "The Machine in the

Landscape," touching on the Indian and Chinese, "the Northwest's forgotten minority."

James Welch, poet and novelist, will finish the series on April 21 with a discussion on "Blackfeet Blood and Piegan Hunters."

All events will be held in CCC's McLoughlin Theatre at 7 p.m. There is no charge.
