

## Sandy man appealing county staff denial

A Sandy man's appeal of a county Planning Division staff denial will be considered next Thursday morning, Feb. 4, by the county hearings officer.

Wallace Warren is appealing a Planning Division staff denial of his temporary permit to continue using a mobile home as a residence while building at the intersection of Latigo Lane and Lusted Road in the Bull Run area.

The hearing will be at 9

a.m. at the Department of Environmental Services in Oregon City.

At 9:45 a.m., a non-forest use application will be considered for property on Wild Cat Creek Road, east of Sandy.

Merle Anderson has filed for a non forest use permit that would allow him to construct a single-family residence on the east side of Wild Cat Creek Road, approximately 1,800 feet south of Highway 26.

## Obituaries

### Charles Baker

Funeral services for Charles W. Baker were held last Friday in the chapel of Sandy Funeral Home. Private interment was at Cliffside Cemetery in Sandy.

He was born Sept. 8, 1919 in Conrad, Mont. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. After his discharge in 1946, he moved to Oregon and married Catherine Muscolo in Vancouver, Wash.

They lived in Portland where Mr. Baker worked in automobile sales. They later moved to Estacada where they owned and operated the Ford dealership.

After selling the automobile business, Mr. Baker began working in the real estate business in Gresham.

After moving to Sandy in 1968, he operated Chuck Baker Real Estate Co. He was involved in the formation of the Independent Bank of Sandy, served as the first chairman of the board and had remained a member of the board of directors since.

He was an avid sportsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing.

He died in a Portland hospital Jan. 19. He was 62. He is survived by his wife, Catherine of Sandy; sons, William Baker of Gresham and Gary Molen of Utah; his mother, Mary C. Baker of Portland, and three grandchildren.

The family suggests memorials be made in his memory to Mt. Hood Hospice, P.O. Box 284, Sandy.

### Jewel Chapman

At the family's request no services were held for Jewel Chapman, a Sandy-Boring area resident for nearly 40 years. She died Jan. 22 at her home in Boring. She was 82.

Mrs. Chapman was born May 30, 1899 in Brewton, Ala., where she was raised and completed her education.

After she married Charles A. Chapman in Tampa, Fla., they lived in Texas. They traveled extensively before moving to Sandy in 1945.

Shortly after her husband's death in 1954, Mrs. Chapman moved to Boring. She is survived by two sisters, Pearl Krum of Oakland, Calif., and Rubye Taylor in Alabama.

Private interment was at Willamette National Cemetery in Portland.
