# Immunization clinic set

Sandy Union High School will hold immunization clinics next week for the feeder elementary schools in its district.

Immunization clinics will be held at the school Thursday and Friday, Feb. 18 and 19, for Sandy High, Boring and Bull Run elementary students. Welches and Cottrell elementary pupils will be included Feb. 19.

Sandy Elementary District students will be immunized Feb. 22 at

Cedar Ridge School.

Though no one will be turned away, inoculations will cost \$5 apiece and must be accompanied by a signed parental consent form obtained at the time of vaccination or at any time prior to the clinic. Students over the age of 15 do not require consent of a parent or guardian but must still sign an authorization form.

Required immunizations for children attending grades 2 through 12 in Oregon schools on March 14, 1982, include diphtheria-tetanus and polio, three doses—unless one or more doses were received prior to age six months in which case a fourth dose is re-

quired; measles, one dose, must be received at or after 12 months of age; and rubella, one dose, must be received at or after 12 months of age and after July 1969.

For children entering Oregon any school from out of state after March 14, and for children attending a facility, pre-school, kindergarten and the first grade on that date or anytime thereafter, minimum requirements are slightly different.
