

Agricultural conference is set for March 7-10

There will be much more than just lectures at Agricultural Conference Days II, according to Martin Hellickson, associate professor of agricultural engineering, and conference co-chairman.

This year's conference is scheduled for March 7-10 at Oregon State University and is open to all Oregonians interested and/or involved in agriculture.

"We will have the meetings of state agricultural organizations and presentations at the conference, but there will also be several seminars on practical topics that people in all segments of agriculture can benefit from," said Hellickson.

The first full day of the conference, Monday, March 8, begins with several presentations on the general theme of "Agriculture - Our World - Our Nation - Our State."

The afternoon sessions include one on the outlook for agriculture in 1982, and another on the use of micro-computers in agriculture.

Day two of the conference gets underway with a general session on high interest rates and agricultural credit, moderated by Manning Becker, OSU extension farm management specialist.

This session will emphasize how agricultural producers can deal with high interest rates and what interest rates may do in the future.

In the afternoon, the seminar on micro-computers will be repeated. In another seminar, Gene Nelson, OSU extension farm management specialist, will discuss changes in income and estate planning for farmers and ranchers made by recent revisions in federal tax law.

The final full day of the conference will be devoted to a symposium on minimum tillage, moderated by Norm Goetze, OSU extension agronomist.

"This session will feature conservation-experienced farmers, machinery manufacturers, chemical industry representatives and public agencies concerned with agricultural production and conservation issues," said Goetze.

Registration forms and complete programs are available in county offices of the OSU Extension Service or from Hellickson's office in the OSU Department of Agricultural Engineering.

Apply early for birth certificates

Sandy residents are urged to apply early for birth certificates needed in order to get benefits from the Social Security Administration.

The Oregon Bureau of Vital Statistics no longer provides personalized service to walk-in customers. A written request for a birth certificate is necessary. It will take about 14 days to get a record.

Proof of age is required by Social Security for various types of benefits. A birth certificate or baptismal certificate made shortly after birth can be used.

When applying for social security one should also be prepared to present a social security card or number (If the claim is on another person's card that number will also be needed); a marriage certificate if applying for wife's, widow's or widower's benefits; birth certificate of children if applying for them; Form W-2 for the last two years or a copy of the last two Federal Income Tax returns for self-employed individuals; names, addresses and telephone numbers of doctors, hospitals and clinics in applying for disability.

Obtaining the necessary documents early will avoid any unnecessary delay in getting benefits.
