Also, discussion on the wetland areas, both within and outside of the boundaries of the Hoodland Service District, will occur.

A map of these areas, as identified by staff members, will be available for public inspection and review.

Last December the Land Conservation and Development Commission directed the county to conduct another inventory of the wetlands in the Mt. Hood corridor.

They were to map the locations and determine quality and quantity.

The re-evaluation of the area's wetlands came after the Environmental Committee on Suitability challenged the Mt. Hood plan when it went before the commission in December for acceptance. ECOS argued that the county had neither properly identified all the wetland areas nor how they would be protected.

Dominic Mancini, planning director, said planning staff members will present the proposed changes to the citizens, and will accept recommendations on the "discussion draft," which was mailed to property owners two weeks ago.

Mancini said that

through citizen involvement changes may be made to what is currently being proposed.

He said that the suggestions from the citizens will be studied by his staff, and may or may not be included in the updated Mt. Hood plan.

A "proposed draft" for the plan should be ready for public inspection after the second informational meeting on April 20.

This draft will be submitted for consideration by the Clackamas County Planning Commission on May 10 at 7:30 p.m. at the Environmental Services Building at 902 Abernethy in Oregon City.

Citizens may appear before the planning commissioners at this meeting and present their views on the revisions, either orally or in writing.

From here the plan will go before the county commissioners in two public hearings to be held on May 26.

The hearing times are 2 and 7:30 p.m. in the commissioners chambers in the Courthouse Annex, 906 Main Street, in Oregon City.

Citizens may also testify at these hearings.
