## Weigh-in set for fair livestock

The Clackamas County Stockmen's Association, the Clackamas County Fair Board and the Oregon State University extension service will again sponsor a feeding and carcass contest for market steers, market lambs and swine entering the 1982 Clackamas County Fair.

Each of these are separate contests, according to Charles March, Sandy, Stockmen's Association chairman.

Steers will be weighed at the fairgrounds in Canby on March 27 from 8 to 10 p.m. Swine will be weighed on May 1 from 8 to 10 a.m. Sheep will be weighed June 5, during the Lamb Show,

from 6:30 to 9 a.m. FFA and 4-H members planning to sell market animals at the Junior Market Livestock Auction must weigh their animals.

Youth entering the carcass contests are required to follow their animals to the slaughter plant, where carcass measurement information will be taken.

After all information on the carcasses has been taken, placings will be made and awards will be presented on the most desirable carcass.

All 4-H and FFA members in the county are reminded that to be eligible must be at the fairgrounds on the respective dates for the weigh-ins.

Not only did Rowe leave behind considerable property in the town of Rhododendron, but also in Columbia County and in the Holladay and Wheeler additions in Portland.

The outstanding mortgages on land sold show that \$3,500 was still owed by the Rhododendron Mineral Springs Land Company from a \$5,000 agreement entered into on April 12, 1912. The remaining balance was two years past due as originally agreed upon.

The Rhododendron Mineral Springs Land Company was an Oregon corporation that was founded on March 20, 1911, by her husband for the purpose of developing a scenic-tourist attraction in the area through real estate development and mineral springs.

A \$3,000 mortgage was due on Dec. 1, 1921, from Susette Franzette, owner of the historic Rhododendron Tavern.

She had purchased the majority of the land, which now is Rhododendron, for \$1 down and six percent interest. That was in November, 1916.

In Rowe's will it is estimated that at the time she entered into agreement with Franzette on Nov. 29, 1916, that 36 lots west of the Zigzag River were worth a mere \$25 a piece.

Thirty-three lots east of the river, where the town's business district is now located, were estimated to

be worth \$100 apiece.

The will also listed a \$1,500 mortgage to Maggie McCarthy. She charged seven percent interest (which was to be paid semiannually). The total amount was due July 3, 1919.

A \$500 mortgage was due on Aug. 16, 1919, from Josephine H. Booth, drawing interest at eight percent and due semiannually.

Also due at some unspecified date was a \$370 second mortgage by a Margaret Nelson, at eight percent and payable annually. At the time of Rowe's death, \$20 had been paid.

Interestingly enough, out of the five mortgages listed in Rowe's will, four of them were with women. The women were sold property after her husband's death on March 20, 1914.

It was her husband who had entered into the agreement to sell land to the Rhododendron Mineral Springs Land Company, not her.

There are hints that each of these women, like Rowe, were without husbands and each was investing in a financial cushion for their later years in life. The resort area was becoming popular and the land values were sure to increase.

Whatever happened to three of the four of these widows is not known. The only one recognized by history is Susette Franzette, whose husband, Emil, had died on Nov. 18, 1916.
