## Slope rule appeals due before mid-May

The slope amendment adopted by the Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners may be appealed to the Land Conservation and Development Commission within 30 days, according to a recent letter circulated by the planning division.

The amendment to the county's zoning and development ordinance to allow developments on slopes in excess of 35 percent may be appealed though the ordinance officially went into effect on April 12.

Citizens or organizations objecting to the ordinance would have until May 12 to submit their concerns in writing to the LCDC.

Grounds for objections

are to be limited to only those raised during the proceedings leading to the adoption of the ordinance. This includes hearings held on Feb. 1 and 8, and the commissioners' hearings on Feb. 22, and April 12.

The original amendment to the ordinance was written to accommodate hydroelectric development, which depends on steep slopes for the generation of power. However, when the planning staff submitted the written draft to the planning commission they revised the original amendment to include other developments, as long as it meets certain requirements.

## Cedar Ridge plagued by fire

The brush fire that struck the Cedar Ridge area near Brightwood March 24 raised the total number of fires to four in the past year, making it the state's highest fire danger area, according to the Oregon State Forestry department.

Assistant District Ranger Robert Lundblad said that the wooded tract

of land that surrounds Miller Road has been a major problem for the Oregon State Forestry department as well as the Hoodland Rural Fire District, which assists in fire suppression.

Lundblad said that the latest fire, which struck the area on March 24, is still under investigation but is believed not to be the result of arson. He said that in the other cases the fires were the work of an arsonist, who has plagued

both public and private land owners the past three years and been dubbed the "Zigzag Arsonist."

The "Zigzag Arsonist," according to Lundblad, strikes either during the early morning hours or late at night. Also, it is believed by some authorities that this arsonist is not just one person, but several.

Fires in this area are common, said Lundblad, and occur on the average of twice a year. He said that primarily just grasses and ferns have been destroyed, but no trees.

Lundblad said that arson-related fires have been on the increase in the state over the past year, which is typical during a time of recession.

The fires that struck the Cedar Ridge area last summer and fall have been attributed to a carelessly thrown cigarette butt, a bottle heated by the sun, and a muffler dragging on the ground, said Lundblad.

Lundblad said the fires in the area, although they have never burned any considerable portion of land, have been a headache since they occur during high fire hazard times and cost them in both manpower and time.

This summer Lundblad said that the state will attempt to develop a public fire prevention effort in the Cedar Ridge area to help curb the problems of brush fires.
