

7 VICA members do well at state

Seven Sandy Union High School students finished well in the recent VICA state competition at Chemeketa Community College in Salem.

Approximately 400 students from 42 high schools competed.

Junior Roman Scott won the commercial art division.

He designed a poster for a rock 'n' roll band.

Senior Brent Plaster also earned a first-place finish. He fabricated a book case using different types of joints and materials. Some of the joints were glued, while others required nails or screws.

Plaster received a polisher-buffer power tool, and a \$500 cash award for traveling expenses to the national competition in Atlanta, Ga.

Senior Tod Simpkins placed second in arc welding, which required the use of low-hydrogen welding rod. He had to make vertical and overhead T-joint welds.

Simpkins was given an arc welding hood by Gresham Welding Supply.

Senior Don Casey finished second in machine shop competition. He used a milling machine, a drill press, a metal lathe and a grinder. He fabricated a machine part, including tapers and holes.

A dial caliper went along with the second-place finish.

Senior Greg Meier finished fourth in the job interview competition.

He was required to submit a resume two weeks before the competition, and

then filled out applications and was interviewed at Salem.

"You have to have a lot of poise, good communications skills," Lynn Sodenaa, assistant VICA advisor, said of the job interview competition.

Senior Ron Cook finished sixth in oxyacetylene welding. He was judged for his ability with a cutting torch, and for his horizontal, vertical and flat welds.

Junior Ron Myers finished sixth in small gas engines. Some troubleshooting was involved. Tool identification and the use of a micrometer were also factors.

Sodenaa said that he is pleased with the outcome. Twenty students attended the spring conference. Sandy probably would have been fourth if school team scores had been kept.

"We had a good group of kids to work with," Sodenaa said.
