"Right now there are virtually no standards for siting hydroelectric projects," said Sullivan. "The existing ones dealing with hydros right now are there only to mitigate the problems caused by these facilities."
Last week Ron Stangel of the planning staff said that even though the standards for locating hydros proposed by the citizen's committee have not been adopted, and will probably undergo a number of changes after organizations and citizen planning groups comment

on it, Sanders will be held accountable to the provisions of the first draft.
The stipulation and order states that "Mr. Sullivan and his clients promise that none of them, acting individually or through any other individuals, associations, or entities, shall seek administrative or judicial review of the Court Order, or in any way, directly or indirectly, attempt to have this Court Order voided."
Sanders intends to begin construction early this summer and complete the project in September.
