Massey said that the biggest problem he could see was a culvert that runs underneath Henry Creek Road, which was installed by Clackamas County shortly after a flood in 1964-65 (which occurred over a period of months that winter), destroying a wooden bridge at that location.

Massey said that the downstream opening of the culvert prevents most fish from passing upstream since there is a three foot jump the fish must make to get into the pipe.

To correct the existing situation, Massey said that the water level of the creek bed at the western opening of the culvert would have to be raised two feet by the placement of rocks.

Another problem identified with the culvert was the debris build-up at the upstream opening.


