# Adventists fete services director

Sandra Potter Marquardt, Community Services director for the city of Sandy, received the 1982 Community Services Award of the Sandy Seventh-day Adventist Church Saturday, May 1.

The presentation which honored her for outstanding community service was made by Pastor Bernell Clark as part of the church's community relations day. More than 350

persons attended the ceremony, including church members and friends from the Sandy area.

Clark commended Marquardt for significant contributions to the quality of life in Sandy through a wide range of activities which she helps coordinate. Among them, he said, were programs designed to help senior citizens, such as the Loaves and Fishes meals

provided at the Senior Center each weekday, and area-wide emergency relief planning.

Marquardt's work brings her together often with the Adventist church. The congregation conducts a continuing program of welfare services for needy persons, and often those who come seeking assistance are referred to the church by the city.

The church's community

services center, located on the north side of the intersection of Highway 26 and University Avenue, recently was designated as the community's central emergency shelter for use in time of natural disaster or at times when people are evacuated and stranded and in need of food, clothing and shelter. Marquardt is the coordinator of the city program.

The church has been a

long-time supporter of the Loaves and Fishes program, with financial contributions to sustain the program and regular participation by the "Dorcas" ladies of the church who help prepare and serve some of the meals.
