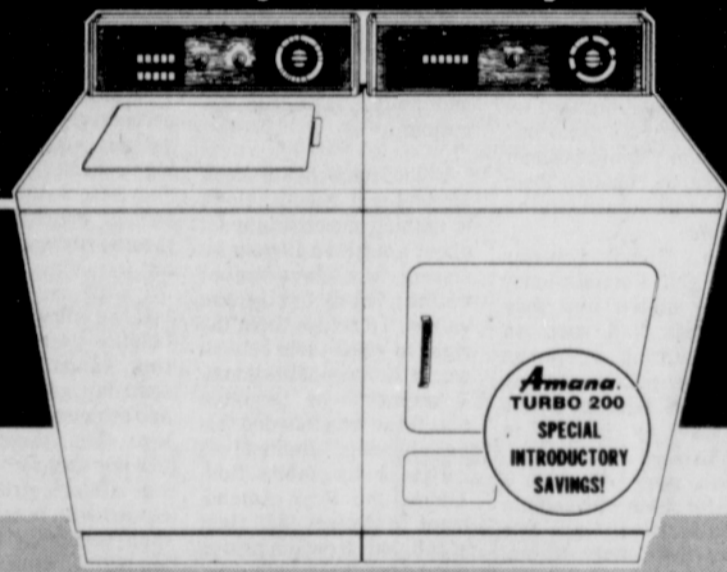
The girls are attempting to raise money to attend their Grand Assembly June 24-26 in Corvallis.

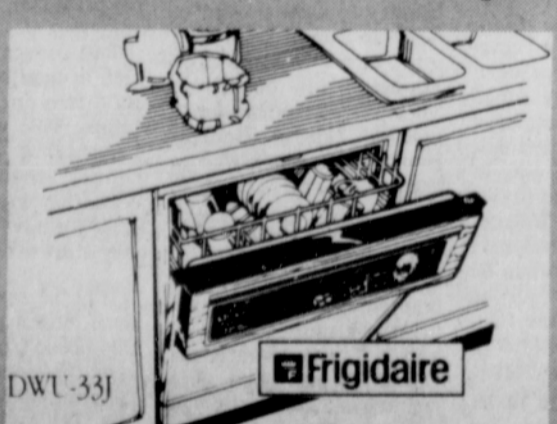

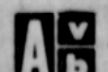
