Woodcutters warned about fire

Sandy area residents heading for the hills to cut some firewood in the Mt. Hood National Forest face special restrictions as summer weather increases fire danger.

Firewood cutters in the national forest must carry firefighting tools during fire season. Required are a long-handled shovel, a one-gallon bucket and a fire extinguisher with a minimum capacity of eight ounces.

All chainsaws must have a spark arrestor with .023-inch mesh screen.

Cutting days can be regulated, depending on fire danger. The danger is rated on a scale of a low of A to a high of F. Firewood cutting is allowed only on Class A and B days.

A Forest Service recording reports daily fire wilderness area conditions dangers at 667-7979. Other recording at 667-5406.


