Mime group slips into Sandy

The nationally acclaimed Oregon Mime Theatre makes its way soundlessly into Sandy next Friday, Aug. 20, with a performance at the Sandy Community Center at 10 a.m.

The presentation is sponsored by Clackamas County Arts Council and Sandy Public Library.

"With mime, the interplay between the mime actor and the audience is a kind of holy thing," said Dutch-born Francisco Reynders, who is both performer and founding director of the company that also includes Elizabeth Page and Burl Ross.

"Something is created during the silence that is unexplainable in words," he added, "Yet, if done well, it will be understood by everyone."

Without the assistance of sound effects, elaborate costumes or props, the audience will see a hair-raising mountain climb, the life of everywoman from birth to death, a man trapped on a conveyor belt and the majestic flight of an eagle.

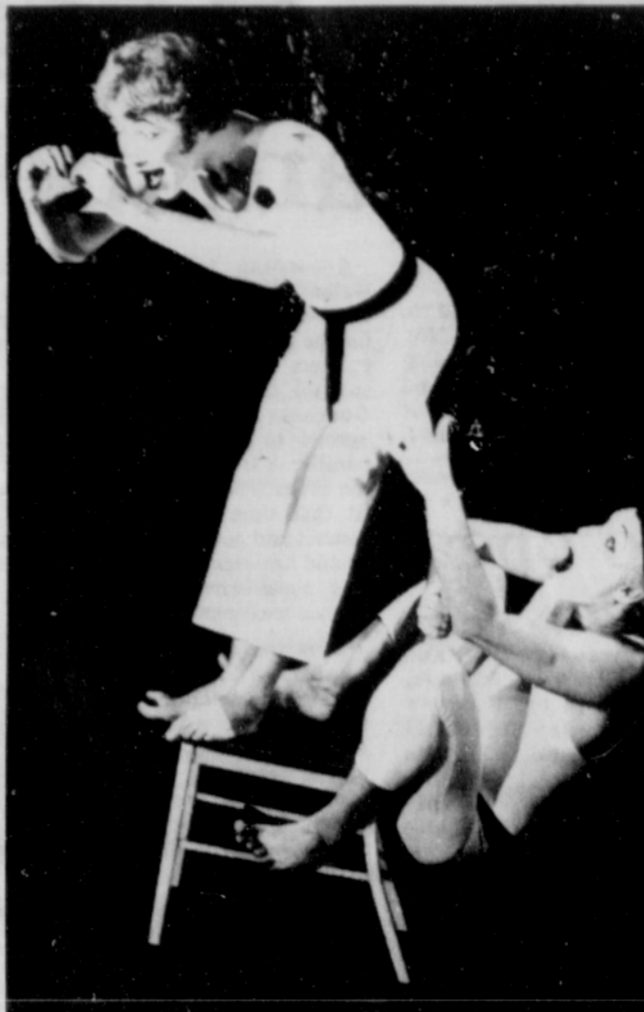
In short, the program is a series of mime works that, in Reynders' words, attempt to "tickle the full range of human emotions"—not the least of which is laughter.

Audience participation plays an important role. The children cease being onlookers and become part of the action on stage.

The Oregon Mime Theatre, now in its eighth season, tours from its home base in Lake Oswego. The company has performed before audiences across the nation from packed igloos in Alaska to standing-room-only crowds in Jacksonville, Fla.

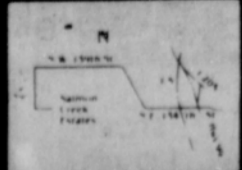
