Sandy man arrested after shooting

A 23-year-old Sandy man was arrested by police after a shooting incident early Sunday morning. Arrested at the scene and lodged in the Clackamas County jail was Bluee Steele of 18020 Weaver

Court, Sandy. Steele lists his occupation as apartment house manager. Bail has been set at \$50,000.

He was charged with recklessly endangering another's life, carrying a dangerous weapon with intent to use, and second degree assault.

Originally Steele was also charged with attempted murder, according to Sandy Chief of Police Fred Penzel. This charge was dropped Monday, Aug. 22, by the Clackamas County district attorney's office.

Penzel said his department received a report of a

shooting at Steele's duplex on Weaver Court at 4:50 a.m.

Injured in the incident was Charlene Emerson, early 20s, of Seattle. She reportedly had been living at Steele's residence for four days prior to the shooting, according to Penzel.

Penzel said Emerson was shot in the breast and transported to Gresham Community Hospital, where she was admitted for a "flesh wound."

The victim reportedly underwent surgery later that morning.

Emerson reportedly left the hospital that evening and returned to the scene to get her car. She is now reportedly living in Portland.

Penzel said Steele's residence was placed under guard until 5 p.m. Sunday, while investigators from his department searched the scene for evidence.

On Monday, Clackamas County District Court Judge Robert D. Burns scheduled Steele's arraignment for Aug. 30 at 8:45 p.m.

Penzel said Steele's case will probably be heard by a grand jury within the next two weeks.
