Ranger award started

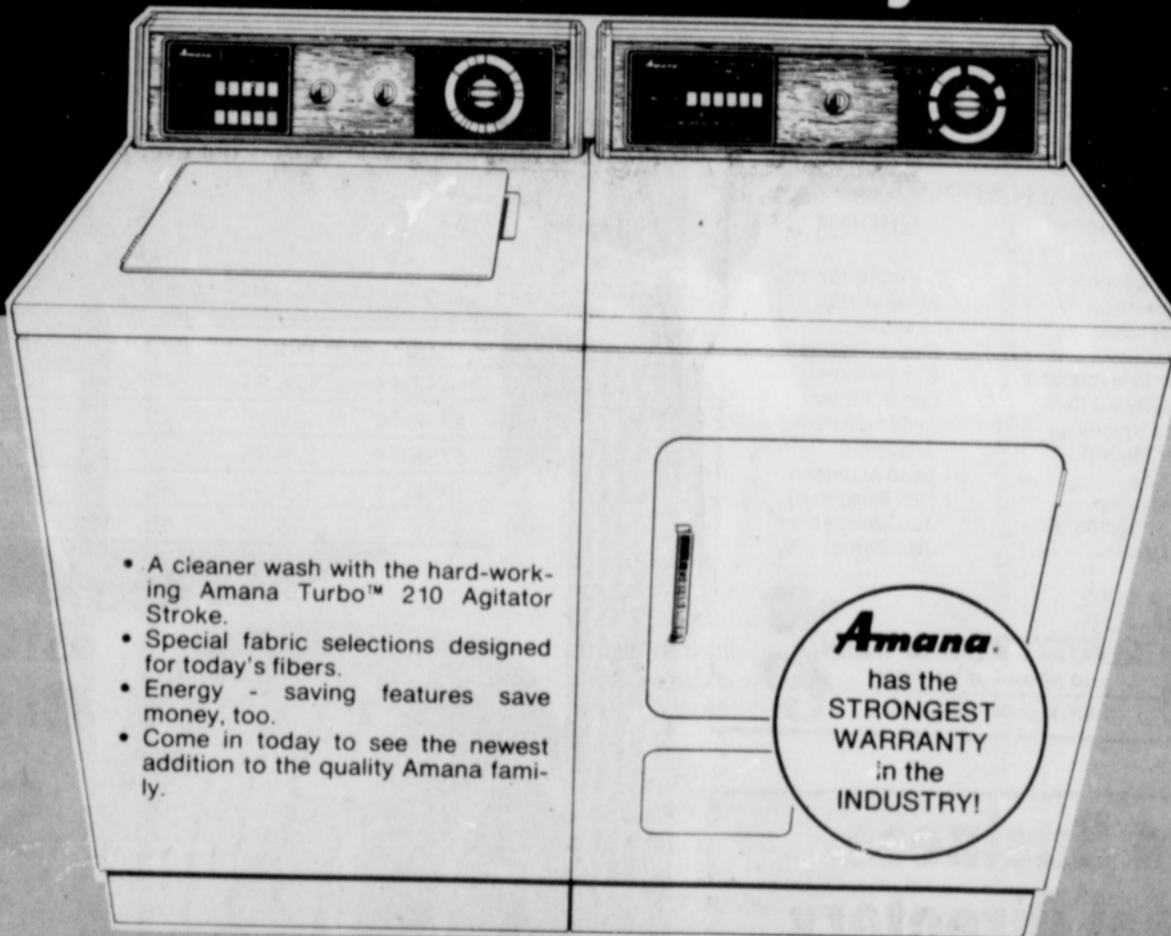
