### Baha'is celebrate Peace Day

In observance of World Peace Day, the Baha'is of Sandy have invited the public to join them at a meeting this Sunday, Sept. 19, at 7 p.m. in the Sandy Community Center.

Nasrollah Rassekh, chairman of the Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is in Portland and a history professor and Lewis and Clark College, will speak on "The Baha'i Plan for World Peace."

World Peace Day was initiated in 1959 by the National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is in the United States. Its purpose is to call attention to the urgent need for the establishment of a lasting peace among nations.

The teachings of Baha'u'llah, prophet-founder of the Baha'i Faith, call for the establishment of a world commonwealth and federal government designed to bind the inter-dependent nations of the world together and govern them with equity and justice.

The Baha'i writings emphasize that the principle task of the world government is the maintenance of a lasting peace. Baha'u'llah wrote, "It is hoped that through the favor of the appearances of the power of God, the armaments of the world will be changed into peace, and corruption and conflict will vanish among men."

### Biblical seminar planned

## Fire district hosts Explorer Post

Sandy Fire District will sponsor a new Explorers Post for young adults, 16 through 20 years of age, who are interested in opportunities in fire sciences.

Scouts will follow the regular training schedule of the volunteer firefighters, said Fire Chief Bob Rathke. That includes firefighting and emergency medical techniques.

An orientation meeting kicks off the post this Saturday, Sept. 18, at 10 a.m. at the district's main station, 17460 Bruns St.

Parents are invited to attend this first meeting. Potential scouts under 18

years of age will be asked to have a signed permission slip from their parents.

The new Explorer Scouts post replaces the high school auxiliary club which the fire district sponsored for a number of years. "We feel the Explorer program gives kids a more meaningful experience," Rathke said.

Before, they had to be in high school, he continued. Now, they can continue with the post after they graduate and possibly become involved as volunteers or paid firefighters.

The Explorers will advance through the program with four levels. With completion of the fourth level, Rathke said, the Explorer would be the equivalent of a volunteer, however would not be a member of that organization.

The club will meet 9 a.m. Saturdays at Sandy Fire District. Post officers will be the leaders of the

organization. "They'll basically be running their own organization," Rathke said.

He anticipates that along with drills, the Explorers will visit other fire departments in the area. Social activities will be determined by post members.

Membership will be limited to 20 participants.

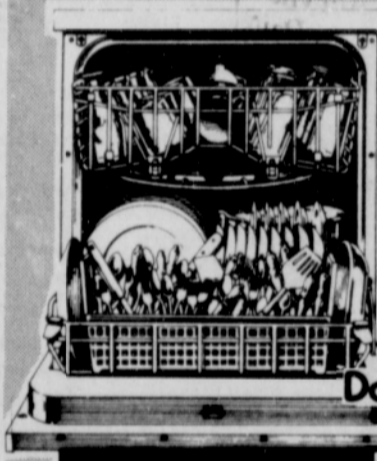

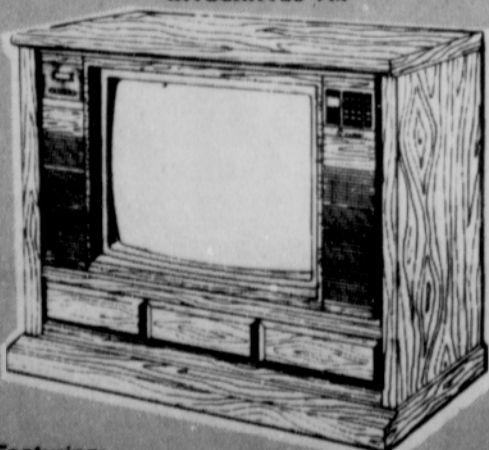

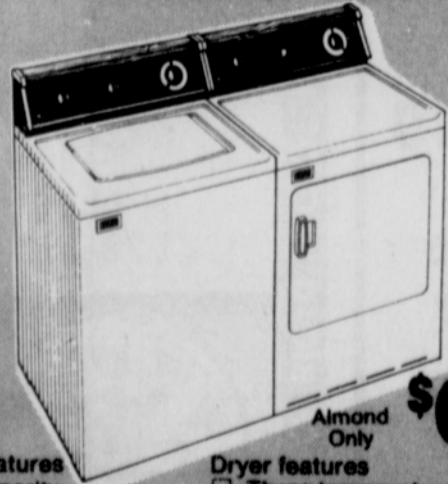
