## Welches teachers reject proposal

The Welches Education Association met Monday afternoon to discuss the latest counter-proposal made by the school board.

Members of the board met in executive session Thursday night, Sept. 9, and drafted the proposal, hoping to resolve the nine-month-old contract dispute.

Tom Well, chief negotiator for WEA, said progress is being made in the negotiations. However, the latest offer from the school board didn't totally satisfy the 21 full-time and one part-time teacher who, Monday, began their 75th

day without a contract.

Wells said late Tuesday evening that he has sent a message to Dick Hoffman, school board president, explaining that members of the WEA wish to sit down with the board and work out their differences.

"Personally, I think we are too close to keep sending letters back and forth," said Well. "Hopefully, we can sit down and hammer things out."

"We want to sit down in a room, lock the door, and then throw away the key until we can get something worked out."
