Her duties will enable

seniors to gain access to services which will promote their well-being and independent lifestyle while remaining at home.

Emphasis will be placed on the homebound and frail persons, encouraging them to take advantage of services such as telephone reassurance, grocery delivery, friendly visitation, information and referral and transportation.
