

Sandy youth hurt in wreck

A 6-year-old Sandy boy was slightly injured Sunday afternoon when the bicycle he was riding collided with a car driven by a Gresham man.

James C. McCulloch was riding his bicycle west on Pleasant Street when he collided with the car at the

intersection of Pleasant and Scales Avenue.

McCulloch told police that he did not see the stop sign at the intersection and proceeded through when he was struck by a 1982 Chevrolet Chevette driven by Terry Edwin Jay, 41.

Jay, who was driving

south from Hood Street, told Sandy police he didn't see the youngster in time, braked his car too late and struck the cyclist.

McCulloch was taken to Gresham Community Hospital where he was treated for minor injuries and released. No citations were issued.
