The top bowler in the Rockwood Lanes junior program, which is the largest in the metropolitan area, is Amy Rutledge of Boring.

Rutledge, 15, has a 170 average in the Saturday league, currently the best in the girls division. She also bowls in a traveling league on Sundays, and said she spends about three

nights a week at Rockwood Lanes. That's not unusual, though. Her father also "bowls and bowls and bowls."

She's the daughter of John and Jan Rutledge.

Amy said she's been bowling for eight years. The traveling league takes her to most of the bowling lanes in the metropolitan

area. "I like that. The competition's better," she said.

She carries a 165 average in the traveling league, which keeps her in the top 10. She explained that her lower average in the traveling league is probably due to having to make adjustments for the different lanes.

A 243 is her best score, and contributed to a 600

series. Both of which gave her a mention above the lane on the name board. She has also bowled an 800 series for four games this year.

She'd like to get her average up in the 190s before getting out of the junior league. Juniors range in age from 3 to 22, though Rutledge said most advance to the adult

leagues at 18 or 19.

Being the top bowler in both leagues is a goal that's within her reach, she feels. In September Rutledge won the Northwest Classic B division. The Classic is a monthly tournament held in lieu of the traveling league, though the com-

petition is stiffer than the Sunday league, with other bowlers from around the state participating.

The only drawback to bowling in the traveling league, she said, is that she has to wear "a stupid little skirt."

Rutledge, a sophomore at Sandy Union High School, is a member of the Mountain Echoes newspaper staff, and plays softball.
