Outdoor writer launches publishing house

Rhododendron outdoorsman Michael P. Jones has published a book on whales.

In fact, his "Whales" hardback book isn't his only publishing venture. His own Crumb Elbow Publishing company also produces posters, stationery and bordered scratch pads with wildlife themes.

He said he got the idea for "Whales" from many weekends and summers on the coast, when he observed a healthy whale population that since has dwindled. He also talked with many seaman and explored many coves.

He also has taught school and worked in the Gladstone Historical Society housed in the Gladstone library and along the way noticed a general lack of information about whales.

He responded with a comprehensive book with many sketches, a glossary and cross-reference of whales with various popular names, weights and waters they frequent. The book was designed as an easy learning tool for both children and adults.

Book Place in Sandy and Welches carries both limited editions and special collectors' edition of "Whales," in addition to posters that depict myth of the whale and myth of Moby Dick.

Beard's Frame Shop in Gresham also carries the

posters, while gift shops and art galleries in Newport and Lincoln City also carry his work.

"I was shocked at the things they didn't have in regard to whales and sealife," Jones said of his own marketing trip to the Oregon coast shops.

He figures pollution of the ocean is as much reason for demise of whales as commercial whalers. Walking the Longbeach peninsula as a boy, he noted disappearance of clams from gunnysack limits, replacement of beach shells with

plastic and sudden disappearance of days when seals and whales on the beach were common.

"The ocean's dying," Jones laments, "yet scien-

tists think the ocean's our future breadbasket."

The noted irony of age-old whalers that once supposedly left the sea to sprout legs and returned to the sea for survival.

"There still are a lot of private whalers," he said. "People, however, tend not to be concerned about another mammal. They're more concerned about the economy, the holocaust, the arms race and putting food in the stomachs of other families."

Publishing the book and stationery meant operating his own binder and headliner, in addition to forming his own publishing house to secure a Library of Congress number and copyright.

His recent efforts aren't the only works his Crumb Elbow Publishing has produced or plans, however.

Just before Christmas, Jones published a book of poems by Estacada's Fred Carlson, 70-year-old former clerk of the works

in Welches.

Jones gathered up poems Carlson had scribbled on napkins, cereal boxes and scraps of paper dating back to 1940 to publish "Thoughts in Time."

Like "Whales," the Carlson book was printed by Grace Meader, former Sandy Fast Print manager who now operates Printing with Grace in Gresham.

Jones also plans two children's books set in Hoodland soon. The kids' books will be published under the name Elbow Books, while other books may appear under the name Meadow Creek Press—both subdivisions of Jones' Crumb Elbow Publishing in Rhododendron.

He said he's almost finished another book on bears and plans a four-book sealife series focusing on whales in all.

To do all this, he plans to beef up his Rhododendron shop with a word-processing machine with printer.

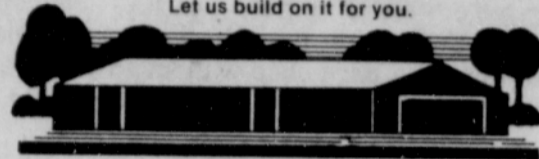


