Welches studies child abuse program

Child abuse is increasing in Clackamas County and Welches Grade School is taking steps to institute a personal safety program for its students.

Linda Miller, chairperson of the school's educational screening committee, endorses the project. Miller, a Clackamas County juvenile counselor, last Thursday gave the school board some shocking statistics on "an epidemic of cruelty."

Figures released by the Children's Services Division of Oregon for 1982, show there were 3,308 reported cases of child abuse. Miller said these figures will increase because the represent just 11 months. In 1981, there were just 2,509 cases reported.

"The elements of child abuse range from certain-aged children being left

alone or children living in an environment that could lead to their physical harm—to the extreme of children having bruised, broken bones and being sexually molested," she said.

Perpetrators in the cases of physical abuse and sexual molestation have been identified, said Miller. They include neighbors, friends, babysitters and relatives.

"We're finding out in our department now, more often it's even a teen-ager on little kids of either sex," said Miller.

The county's juvenile department has not yet compiled their statistics for 1982, said Miller "but in 1981 there were 78 total reported and confirmed cases of child abuse." In 43

of these cases the children were the victims of some sort of sexual molestation.

"Even without our statistics being compiled," said Miller, "we have seen a very definite increase in all forms of child abuse, but particularly in sexual molestation."

Miller attributes the increase in reports "partly due to better reporting laws that require both private and public counselors, doctors, school administrators, teachers, etc. to report any suspected child abuse."

The other contributing factor to increase child abuse cases is that "communities are better educated, informed and aware."

Although child abuse has also been given the term,

"conspiracy of silence" because children were either afraid or too embarrassed to report the incident, this is changing. The children themselves are becoming better educated and are beginning to make reports.

"They know they have

the right by law, to be protected from physical bodily harm of all forms," said Miller.

The school board voted unanimously in favor of the program. It is tentatively scheduled to begin in February.
